Weekend closures on the Central line



CLOSURES on the Central line for the next two weekends will enable a raft of improvement works to be carried out.

Together with upgrades in the Leytonstone area, a platform at Buckhurst Hill station will also be rebuilt at the same time, removing the need for separate closures.

For the fastest journeys to central London this weekend and next, replacement bus services will connect with National Rail services at Chingford, Ilford, Stratford and Walthamstow Central for onward journeys to Liverpool Street. Replacement and local buses will also connect with the District, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee

and Victoria lines.

Central and Waterloo & City line general manager, Tricia Ashton said: 'The package of work we are carrying out as part of the Tube improvement plan will result in improved service reliability and provide passengers with a more comfortable ride.'

Valid Tube tickets and Oyster cards will also be accepted on National Rail services and local bus routes in the affected areas.

■ For detailed travel advice, including a map of alternative services, pick up a 'Central line closures' leaflet from Tube stations east of Liverpool Street.

There are no planned track works on the Circle, District, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee, Metropolitan, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or London Tramlink. However, the following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works:

Bakerloo line

Part closure

Sunday: No service between Queen's Park and Harrow & Wealdstone owing to Network Rail engineering work. A rail replacement bus service will operate Queen's Park – Kensal Green – Willesden Junction. For stations north of Willesden Junction please use London Overground services.

Edgware Road: Closed all weekend until late December owing to lift replacement work. Edgware Road (Circle and Hammersmith & City lines) is the nearest alternative station. Trains from here connect with Bakerloo line services at Baker Street and Paddington.

Central line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Bethnal Green and Loughton/Hainault (via Newbury Park). On Sunday, the closure will be extended to Liverpool Street until 8am. This is while drainage is replaced in the Leytonstone area and station improvement work is carried out at Buckhurst Hill. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: Ilford (for Greater Anglia to/from Stratford and Liverpool Street) – Newbury Park – Barkingside – Fullwell Cross (Barkingside) – Fairlop – Hainault

Service B: Walthamstow Central (for Victoria line and Greater Anglia to/from Liverpool Street) – Snaresbrook – Wanstead – Redbridge – Gants Hill – Newbury Park

Service C: Stratford (for Jubilee line, DLR and Greater Anglia) – Leyton – Leytonstone – Snaresbrook – South Woodford – Woodford – Buckhurst Hill – Loughton

Service E: Walthamstow Central (for Victoria line and Greater Anglia) – Snaresbrook – South Woodford – Woodford

Service F: Chingford (for Greater Anglia) – Loughton

At busy times bus journeys between Leytonstone and Leyton may experience significant delays due to heavy traffic in the area. For journeys to/from central London you may find it faster to travel via Chingford, Ilford or Walthamstow Central for Victoria line or National Rail services.

Road closures on Sunday for the Tour of Britain

THE Tour of Britain bike race will finish in London on Sunday. The final stage, which will feature Olympic champion Bradley Wiggins and sprint star Mark Cavendish, will start and finish on Whitehall. The route takes in Victoria Embankment, Upper Thames

Street, Lower Thames Street and Tower Hill.

Road and bridge closures will be in place across the majority of the route.

Overground closure next week

BETWEEN Monday and Friday next week, there will be no London Overground service between Wandsworth Road and Battersea Park owing to Network Rail track work.

The 6.18am train from Battersea Park will start from Clapham Junction (at 6.16am) calling at Wandsworth Road, then all stations to Highbury & Islington.

The 10.17pm train from Highbury &

Islington will call at all stations to Wandsworth Road and terminate at Clapham Junction (at 11.08pm), instead of Battersea Park.

Tickets will be accepted on Southern rail services between Battersea Park and Clapham Junction.

Northern line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Angel and Chalk Farm/Highgate, or between Euston and Chalk Farm/Highgate via Mornington Crescent, owing to new signalling testing. Replacement bus services will run:

Service B: Angel – King's Cross St. Pancras – Camden Town – Kentish Town – Tufnell Park – Highgate – East Finchley

Service C: Finchley Central – West Finchley – Tally Ho Corner (North Finchley) – Arnos Grove (for the Piccadilly line)

Service E: Euston – Mornington Crescent – Camden Town – Chalk Farm

Customers travelling to/from stations north of Finchley Central should connect with the Piccadilly line at Arnos Grove using replacement bus service C. Please be aware, that due to the work, some platform next train indicators may give the incorrect destination. Please check the front of trains for the correct destination.

Docklands Light Railway

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Bank and Tower Gateway, and between Poplar and West India Quay owing to maintenance work. Replacement buses will call at: Bank – Tower Gateway – Shadwell – Limehouse – Westferry – Canary Wharf
