EMPLOYMENT OF DISABLED PERSONS.

I am sending you the enclosed copy of a letter of 7th instant (Ref. No.F.61a) which the President of the British Employers' Confederation has received from the Minister of Labour & National Service on the subject of the Employment of Disabled Workers.

You will note that the Minister, in expressing his appreciation of the helpful attitude which Employers as a whole have shown towards the disablement problem, has asked for their further co-operation in finding openings for disabled persons outside the statutory obligations imposed by the Quota Scheme, and in the making of arrangements for the training of disabled persons for whom room cannot at present be found in the Government's Training Schemes.

The President of the Confederation has assured the Minister that Employers throughout the country will be willing and anxious to do everything in their power to assist in this matter and has asked that this Organisation may be good enough to bring the Minister's letter to the notice of the individual firms in the industry and enlist their co-operation in assisting the Government to deal with this problem.
