### Travel advice for 'Run to the Beat' half-marathon

RUN to the Beat, London's largest half-marathon, takes place on Sunday. More than 19,000 runners will take part, which starts and finishes in Greenwich Park.



All those travelling to the area are advised to avoid driving if possible and use public transport instead.

A large number of roads in the Blackheath, Charlton, Greenwich and Woolwich areas will be closed to traffic on Sunday. Streets on and near the race route will close from 5am, with the last roads due to reopen by 3pm. Parking restrictions will be in place from 6am. Many bus routes will also be affected. The Woolwich Ferry will be suspended while the road closures are in place. There are no planned Tube or rail closures in the Greenwich area.

### Some piers affected during Saturday's Great River Race

THE River Thames will host The Great River Race this Saturday.

During the race the majority of boat services will not be affected, with Londoners and visitors able to continue enjoying River Bus and River Tour services as normal.

As it passes through central London, however, it will be necessary to have a phased closure of some piers to allow competitors to progress safely. Masthouse

Terrace Pier will be closed for around an hour and ten minutes from 11.55am and Canary Wharf Pier will be closed for approximately an hour and 10 minutes from 12.15pm. Tower, Blackfriars, Embankment and Westminster piers will all close for approximately an hour and 10 minutes starting between 12.40pm and 1pm. Services at London Bridge City, Bankside, Festival and London Eye piers may also be affected due to the closure of other piers in the vicinity but London River Services will endeavour to reopen all piers as quickly as possible.

### Don't forget to have your say on Turnham Green

TUBE passengers are being asked for their views on the Piccadilly line, including stopping arrangements at Turnham Green Tube station.

Currently, Piccadilly line trains stop at Turnham Green from the first train until 6.50am Monday to Saturday, and until 7.45am on Sunday.

At night, they stop every evening from 10.30pm until the last train. It means Piccadilly line customers wishing to use Turnham Green station at other times do so by changing to/from the District line elsewhere, such as at Hammersmith, Barons Court or Acton Town.

However, stopping the Piccadilly line at Turnham Green for more of the day would mean reducing the service to other parts of the Piccadilly line, longer journey times passing through Turnham Green and a potentially less reliable service.

This is because trains would have less time at the end of their journey to recover from delays, which reduces the chance of starting their next journey on time.

The engagement runs until October 7.

There are no planned track works on the Bakerloo, Circle, District, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee, Metropolitan, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines or London Tramlank. However, the following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

#### Bakerloo line

#### Station closure

**Edgware Road:** Closed until late December owing to lift replacement work. Edgware Road (Circle and Hammersmith & City lines) is the nearest alternative station. Trains from here connect with Bakerloo line services at Baker Street and Paddington.

#### Central line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between White City and Ealing Broadway/West Ruislip owing to the installation of new drainage in the Acton area and points being replaced at Northolt. Tickets will be accepted on the following National Rail services:

First Great Western services on Saturday, which call at: Greenford – Ealing Broadway – Paddington

Chiltern services all weekend, which call at: West Ruislip – South Ruislip – Marylebone

Replacement buses will also run:

Service A: White City – East Acton – North Acton – West Acton – Ealing Broadway

Service B: White City – North Acton – Northolt – South Ruislip – Ruislip Gardens – West Ruislip

Service C: White City – North Acton – Park Royal (for the Piccadilly line) – Hanger Lane – Perivale – Greenford – Northolt

#### Northern line

#### Part closure

**Sunday:** No service between Camden Town and Edgware before 8.30am southbound, and 9am northbound, owing to new signalling testing. Bus route N5 will call at all affected Northern line stations, except Brent Cross, until services resume.

#### London Overground

#### Part closure

**Sunday:** No service between Richmond and Willesden Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Between Richmond and Gunnersbury, use the District line. Between Gunnersbury and Willesden Junction, tickets will be accepted on the replacement buses which will call at: Gunnersbury – South Acton – Acton Central – Willesden Junction.

**Sunday:** No service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Tickets will be accepted on the replacement buses which will call at: Canada Water – Surrey Quays – Queens Road Peckham – Peckham Rye – Denmark Hill – Clapham High Street – Wandsworth Road – Clapham Junction.

#### Docklands Light Railway

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Westferry and Beckton owing to track maintenance. Valid tickets will be accepted on the replacement buses which will call at: Westferry – Canary Wharf – Blackwall – East India – Canning Town – Custom House for ExCeL – Prince Regent – Royal Albert – Beckton Park – Cyprus – Gallions Reach – Beckton.

Royal Victoria (for the Emirates Air Line) will be served by a shuttle bus operating between Canning Town and ExCeL.
