825 The Secretary presented a Cash Statement to date  
of the finances of the Company, which was read

826 The Secretary reported that Messrs. Speyer Brothers  
had on the 6<sup>th</sup> August last purchased for the  
account of this Company 25 Great Northern Piccadilly  
& Brompton Rly. Company Shares of £10. each fully  
paid at 5 $\frac{1}{4}$  and 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  per share brokerage, and stamp  
and fee.

Co. for further advances of £13,447: = and £17,640: = the repayment of these amounts to be secured in the manner provided for in the aforesaid Agreement.
