

# Important travel information for New Millennium Eve

- A Traffic Limitation Zone will be in operation in Central London from 1700 on Friday 31 December.
- Public transport will be operating throughout the night, at a reduced level.
- Bus Services will not operate within the Traffic Limitation Zone, so you should make your way to the special return bus stops located outside the zone. Night Bus services will operate on all routes from 2350 on Friday 31 December until 0600 on Saturday 1 January.
- Some tube stations in the main event area will close just before midnight. A frequent service will run on all lines serving all other stations from 2350 on Friday 31 December until 0400 on Saturday 1 January.
- DLR Tower Gateway station will close at 2350. After midnight all Beckton trains will run to Bank to connect with tube services. Cutty Sark station will close at 1700 on New Year's Eve and reopen at 0900 on New Year's Day.
- National Rail will run restricted services outwards from Central London mainline stations between 0100 - 0400. Please contact your local rail operator for full service details.
