

# Plan your weekend travel

Apart from the Metropolitan line, there are no planned works on any other Underground lines, the DLR or London Trams. However, engineering and improvement works will affect the following services:

## Metropolitan line

## Part closure

**Sunday:** no service between Aldgate and Wembley Park before 9:30am and after 8:30pm. For travel between Aldgate and Baker Street, use the Circle or Hammersmith & City line. Use the Jubilee line for travel between Baker Street and Wembley Park.

## Part closure

### Richmond and Clapham Junction to Stratford route

**Sunday:** no service between Camden Road and Stratford owing to bridge replacement work at Highbury Corner. Replacement buses will run:

- Camden Road – Holloway Road – Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford

### Gospel Oak to Barking route

**Until Sunday:** no service between Gospel Oak and Barking while Network Rail prepares the line to enable new, longer trains to run from this spring. Replacement bus services will run:

- Gospel Oak – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill – Finsbury Park (for Victoria and Piccadilly lines) – Harringay Green Lanes – Seven Sisters (for Victoria line and South Tottenham)
- Walthamstow Central (for Victoria line) – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – East Ham (for District and Hammersmith & City lines) – Barking

At East Ham, eastbound buses will set down only and westbound buses will pick up only.

Use local buses via any reasonable route between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road or Tube services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central, and also between East Ham and Barking.

### Highbury & Islington to New Cross/Clapham Junction/Crystal Palace/West Croydon route

**Sunday:** no service between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Junction owing to bridge replacement work at Highbury Corner. Replacement buses will run:

- Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction

### Liverpool Street to Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters)/Chingford route

**Monday to Thursday:** no service between Hackney Downs and Enfield Town/Cheshunt after 10.30pm owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement bus services will run.

## TfL Rail

## Special service

**Saturday:** reduced service between Chadwell Heath and Shenfield. Trains will operate every 15 minutes between Liverpool Street and Chadwell Heath, calling at all stations, and every 30 minutes beyond Chadwell Heath for all stations to/from Shenfield.

## Gospel Oak to Barking route set to reopen

LONDON Overground trains will run between Gospel Oak and Barking from Monday, following an eight-week closure.

Connecting Gospel Oak station in north London with Barking in the east, the re-opened line will again provide convenient interchanges with the Victoria line at Blackhorse Road, Hammersmith & City and District lines, and c2c services at Barking.

Network Rail has installed new overhead lines to allow longer, electric trains to run from this spring. The new walk-through trains will have increased capacity and feature air conditioning, live network information screens and better reliability. The trains will also improve air quality for people living and working along the route.

The existing diesel trains will be used until the new trains have been fully tested.

Testing of the electrical infrastructure and the

new trains will take place in between normal services and at night so that customer services are not affected.

From Monday, services will run every 15 minutes throughout the day until late evening and at least every 20 minutes after 10pm.

### Date for the diary

Network Rail still needs to carry out some improvements to the Crouch Hill Bridge, which crosses the Gospel Oak to Barking line. This means there will be no London Overground services on the line over the weekend of April 7 and 8.

## Victoria station entrance closure



THE Cardinal Place entrance for Victoria station will be closed this weekend for construction work.

This means there will be no step-free access at Victoria Underground station from 12.45am on Saturday and all day on Sunday.

Trains, including Night Tube services, will continue to operate as normal throughout and the remaining entrances at the station will be open.

Passengers needing step-free access to/from the Victoria line should use the lifts at Vauxhall or Green Park stations and connect to/from Victoria on local bus services (see box for details).

### Victoria to Vauxhall

Buses 2/N2, N136, 185 or 36 (24-hour route) from bus stop L on Vauxhall Bridge Road

### Vauxhall to Victoria

Buses 2/N2, N136, 185 or 36 (24-hour route) from stop A in the bus station

### Victoria to Green Park

Bus 38/N38 from stop D in the bus station

### Green Park to Victoria

Bus 38/N38 from stop H on Piccadilly
