

Plan your weekend travel

Find out about line closures and alternative travel options at tfl.gov.uk

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Jubilee, Metropolitan, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria and Waterloo & City lines, or on the DLR and London Trams. However, engineering and improvement works will affect the following lines and services:

Circle line Part closure

All weekend: no service between Baker Street and Hammersmith/High Street Kensington (via Bayswater). Trains will operate between High Street Kensington and Baker Street (via Aldgate).

Central line Station closure

Bank station: Central line services, including Night Tube, will not stop at Bank station from 12.45am on Saturday morning and all day Sunday. For Bank, exit at St. Paul's station, which is about a ten-minute walk away, or use local bus services 8, N8 or 25.

District line Part closure

All weekend: no service between Edgware Road and High Street Kensington. Before 9am and after 9pm there will also be no service between Earl's Court and Kensington (Olympia).

Hammersmith & City line Part closure

All weekend: no service between Hammersmith and Baker Street.

London Overground Part closure

Richmond and Clapham Junction to Stratford route

Sunday: no service between Camden Road and Stratford owing to bridge replacement work at Highbury Corner. Replacement buses will run:

- Camden Road - Holloway Road - Highbury & Islington - Canonbury - Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) - Hackney Central - Homerton - Hackney Wick - Stratford

Highbury & Islington to New Cross/Clapham Junction/Crystal Palace/West Croydon route

Sunday: no service between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Junction owing to bridge replacement work at Highbury Corner. Also, no service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace owing to Network Rail track and infrastructure work. Replacement buses will run:

- Highbury & Islington - Canonbury - Dalston Junction
- Crystal Palace - Norwood Junction - Selhurst - West Croydon

Liverpool Street to Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters)/Chingford route

Sunday: Bethnal Green will not be served by trains to/from Chingford owing to Network Rail track work. Use Enfield Town/Cheshunt trains.

Romford to Upminster route

Sunday: no service between Romford and Upminster owing to Crossrail construction work. Use local bus route 370.

TfL Rail Part closure

Saturday: reduced service between Chadwell Heath and Shenfield. Trains will run every 15 minutes between Liverpool Street and Chadwell Heath, calling at all stations, and every 30 minutes beyond Chadwell Heath for all stations to/from Shenfield.

Sunday: no service between Stratford and Shenfield. Use the Central line for travel between Stratford and Newbury Park. Replacement buses will run:

- Stratford City - Forest Gate (Romford Road) - Manor Park (Romford Road) - Ilford - Seven Kings - Goodmayes - Chadwell Heath (Wangey Road) - Romford
- Newbury Park - Chadwell Heath (Wangey Road) - Romford - Gidea Park - Harold Wood - Brentwood - Shenfield



Work continues on TfL Rail ahead of the Elizabeth line

STATION and track upgrades continue on TfL Rail between Liverpool Street and Shenfield, which will mean a series of ten weekend closures from Sunday until March as TfL prepares for the opening of the Elizabeth line later this year.

The improvements will include installing new footbridges and lifts at Manor Park, Seven Kings and Maryland, providing step-free access at these stations.

During the closures, Network Rail will install 8km of overhead wires between Ilford and Manor Park, upgrade signals and complete work to link the Elizabeth line tunnels to Shenfield.

Platform canopies at Chadwell Heath, Goodmayes and Ilford will also be repaired and redecorated.

Howard Smith, operations director for TfL Rail, thanked customers for their patience during the

work. 'I apologise for the disruption to regular weekend travel, but it's vital that this work is done to improve the railway and upgrade the stations to make them accessible for all.'

Rail replacement buses will call at all affected stations each weekend, apart from Liverpool Street and Maryland. They will also call at Newbury Park for the Central line.

Did you know?

All stations on the Elizabeth line will be step-free when fully complete, supporting the Mayor's plan to have 40 per cent of the Underground step-free by 2022.

Victoria station entrance closure

THE Cardinal Place entrance at Victoria Underground station will be closed this weekend as work continues on the station canopy.

This means there will be no step-free access at the Tube station from 12.45am on Saturday and all day on Sunday.

Trains, including Night Tube services, will continue to operate as normal and the remaining entrances at the station will be open.

Passengers needing step-free access to/from the Victoria line should use the lifts at Vauxhall or Green Park stations and connect to/from Victoria on local bus services (see box right).

Victoria to Vauxhall

Buses 2/N2, N136, 185 or 36 (24-hour route) from bus stop L on Vauxhall Bridge Road

Vauxhall to Victoria

Buses 2/N2, N136, 185 or 36 (24-hour route) from stop A in the bus station

Victoria to Green Park

Bus 38/N38 from stop D in the bus station

Green Park to Victoria

Bus 38/N38 from stop H on Piccadilly
