

LONDON TRANSPORT

-----INSPECTION AND TEST OF ROTHERHITHE FLOOD GATES.

During NON-TRAFFIC HOURS, a Lift Department Foreman and a Signal Department Inspector will make a regular inspection and test of each flood gate at Rotherhithe. Each gate will be examined at fortnightly intervals.

The following arrangements will apply in regard to this inspection and test:-

The Lift Department Foreman or the Signal Department Inspector will telephone the Traffic Controller from the flood gate position requesting authority for the gate concerned to be reopened, and the Traffic Controller will authorise, by telephone, the Flood Gate Attendant to reopen that gate.

The gate must then be operated to the instructions of the Lift Department Foreman and the Signal Department Inspector until completion of the test, unless an instruction to close the gate is received from the Traffic Controller.

Immediately the test has been completed, the Flood Gate Attendant must close the gate, unless he has received instructions to the contrary from the Traffic Controller.

The result of the inspection and test will be recorded in the log book at the flood gate position, and the entry signed by both the Lift Department Foreman and the Signal Department Inspector.
