

Plan your weekend travel

Find out about line closures and alternative travel options at tfl.gov.uk

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Jubilee, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway or London Trams. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works. There is also a Tube strike planned that will affect many stations in central London from Sunday evening.

Circle line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Aldgate and Edgware Road, via Victoria, owing to engineering and signal work. Use alternative Tube lines and/or buses.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Embankment and West Ham owing to engineering work and Crossrail construction.

Replacement buses operate between Tower Hill and Canning Town:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for Jubilee line and Docklands Light Railway).

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Liverpool Street and Barking owing to engineering work and Crossrail construction.

Customers can use the District line between West Ham and Barking.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Aldgate and Wembley Park owing to engineering and signal works. Use the Circle, Hammersmith & City or Jubilee lines for alternative routes.

London Overground

Part closure

Romford to Upminster route

All weekend: no service between Romford and Upminster owing to Crossrail construction work and Network Rail track work. Use local buses.

Highbury & Islington to West Croydon/Clapham Junction route

All weekend: no service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell owing to Crossrail construction work. Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland or local buses between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Junction.

Use London Underground services via all reasonable routes (entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only). Replacement buses will run between Dalston Kingsland and Shadwell.

Saturday: no service between Surrey Quays and New Cross owing to Crossrail construction work. Use local buses or New Cross Gate station for connecting trains via Surrey Quays.

Sunday: no service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will run: Canada Water – Surrey Quays – Queens Road Peckham – Peckham Rye – Denmark Hill – Clapham High Street – Wandsworth Road – Clapham Junction.

Richmond/Clapham Junction to Stratford route

Sunday: no service between Clapham Junction and Kensington (Olympia) owing to Earls Court development work.

Watford Junction to Euston route

Sunday: no service between Kilburn High Road and Euston from 11.30am until 9.15pm owing to Network Rail work at Euston to enable High Speed Two (HS2). Use local buses or Underground services.

Gospel Oak to Barking route

Until late February: no service between Gospel Oak and Barking owing to Network Rail work to enable new, longer trains to run from next year. Replacement bus services will operate.

Service J: Gospel Oak (bus stops in Highgate Road) – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill (bus stops in Hornsey Road) – Finsbury Park – Harringay Green Lanes – Seven Sisters (for South Tottenham).

Service T: Walthamstow Central – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road (bus stops at Harrow Green) – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – East Ham – Barking.

For travel between Seven Sisters and Walthamstow Central, use the Tube or local buses.

TfL Rail

Part closure

Every weekend in February and March: no service between Liverpool Street and Shenfield for Network Rail track work and station improvements, plus Crossrail construction work. Replacement buses will run:

Stratford – Forest Gate – Manor Park – Ilford – Seven Kings – Goodmayes – Chadwell Heath – Romford.

Newbury Park (for the Central line) – Chadwell Heath – Romford – Gidea Park – Harold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield.

Advance warning of Tube strike

CUSTOMERS should be aware that a Tube strike is planned from Sunday evening. If it goes ahead there will be a significant impact on Tube journeys from 8pm on Sunday until about 9am on Wednesday February 8.

Custom House station closed

CUSTOM House DLR station will be closed from today until late December.

Passengers travelling to Custom House are advised to walk or use buses from nearby Prince Regent or Royal Victoria DLR stations, both of which are step-free. If travelling to ExCeL, use Prince Regent DLR station. Alternatively, Royal Victoria DLR station is a short walk away.

While the station is closed, a new floor and stairs will be installed to link with the new footbridge, which will remain open throughout the station closure. The works will increase capacity and allow easy interchange ahead of new Elizabeth line services from December 2018.

Step-free access at North Greenwich

WORK to refurbish one of the lifts at North Greenwich station begins on Tuesday until late June.

During the work, customers requiring step-free access to enter the station should follow signs across Peninsula Square to an alternative lift, where they can use the telephone provided to gain access from a member of staff, who will help passengers enter the station.

If customers need further assistance from the main station entrance, a separate telephone will be available to call a member of staff.

Customers should remember to touch in and out on the yellow card reader next to the alternative lift to ensure they pay the correct fare and allow extra time for journeys.
