

# Plan your weekend travel

With the exception of the Circle, District and Hammersmith & City lines, there are no planned works on any other Tube lines this weekend or on London Trams. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

## Circle line

## Part closure

**All weekend:** no service between Edgware Road and Aldgate (via Victoria) owing to new signal testing, and track and drainage works at Tower Hill. A 10-minute service will run between Hammersmith and Aldgate only. Use alternative Tube lines and/or local buses.

## District line

## Part closure

**All weekend:** no service between Embankment and West Ham owing to track and drainage works at Tower Hill and Crossrail construction work at Whitechapel. Replacement buses will call at:

- Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and DLR)

## Hammersmith & City line

## Part closure

**All weekend:** no service between Liverpool Street and Barking owing to new signal testing and Crossrail construction work at Whitechapel. Replacement buses will run – see the District line entry for details.

## London Overground

## Part closure

### Gospel Oak to Barking route

**Sunday:** no service between Gospel Oak and Barking owing to Network Rail works to allow new, longer trains to run from 2018. Replacement buses will run between Gospel Oak and Seven Sisters (for South Tottenham and Victoria line), and between Walthamstow Central (for the Victoria line) and Barking.

Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road, or Tube services between Seven Sisters and Walthamstow Central, and between East Ham and Barking.

### Highbury & Islington to New Cross/Clapham Junction/ Crystal Palace/West Croydon route

**All weekend:** trains will not call at Whitechapel owing to Crossrail construction work at the station. Use local buses.

**Sunday:** no service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will run between Canada Water and Clapham Junction.

### Liverpool Street to Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters)/ Chingford and Romford to Upminster route

**All weekend:** no service between Edmonton Green and Cheshunt owing to Network Rail infrastructure work. Use local buses via any reasonable route or Greater Anglia services between Liverpool Street and Cheshunt (via Tottenham Hale).

**All weekend:** no service between Hackney Downs and Chingford owing to Network Rail infrastructure work. Replacement buses will run.

## DLR

## Part closure

**All weekend:** no service between Stratford and Bow Church owing to Crossrail construction work at Pudding Mill Lane. Use local buses.

## TfL Rail

## Part closure

**Saturday:** no service between Liverpool Street and Stratford, and between Chadwell Heath and Shenfield. Use the Central line or Greater Anglia services, which will call at all stations between Chadwell Heath and Shenfield.

**Sunday:** no service between Ilford and Shenfield until around 8am. Replacement buses will run.

The service changes are owing to Network Rail track and station improvements, and Crossrail construction work.

## Transport for Derby day

A SPECIAL bus service is running between Morden station and Epsom racecourse tomorrow for people travelling to the Derby.

Bus 864 will leave every 20 minutes from a temporary stop in London Road, opposite Morden Tube station, between 10am and 6.20pm.

The last bus back will leave the racecourse at around 7.35pm.

The service is being operated by Go-Ahead and no other tickets or passes are valid on this service. Oyster card holders can, however, get a discount.

Adult fares are £7 single, £12 return (£5 and



£10 respectively for Travelcard/Oyster card holders, children and concessions).



## Travelling with children

If you are planning a trip to London with the kids over the summer, get a Zip Oyster photocard for discounted travel.

### Under 11 years

Children travel free on buses and trams. They also travel free on Tube, DLR, London Overground, TfL Rail and most National Rail services in London with a 5-10 Zip Oyster photocard.

### 11-15 years

Youngsters travel free on buses and trams and travel at child rate on Tube, DLR, London Overground, TfL Rail and most National Rail services in London with an 11-15 Zip Oyster photocard.

### 16-18 years

Young people pay as you go at half the adult rate on bus, Tube, tram, DLR, London Overground, TfL Rail and most National Rail services in London with a 16+ Zip Oyster photocard. They can also buy child rate Travelcard season tickets.

■ If your child doesn't have a 5-10 Zip Oyster photocard, or is aged under 5, they can travel free on bus, Tube, tram, DLR and most rail services in London when accompanied by an adult. For more information, visit [tfl.gov.uk/fares-and-payments](https://tfl.gov.uk/fares-and-payments).
