DLR strike dates announced

THE RMT union has announced that its members employed by Serco on the Docklands Light Railway intend to take strike action:

- From 4.30am January 29 until 4.30am January 31
- From midday February 4 until midday February 6

DLR services will be affected during this time so customers are advised to check before they travel and visit tfl.gov.uk for the latest updates.

Accessibility changes at Kilburn and Waterloo

FROM Tuesday, there will be no step-free access at Kilburn Tube station until mid-May and at Waterloo Tube station until late-July, while lift maintenance work is carried out. Customers for Waterloo are advised to use nearby Westminster or Southwark stations for step-free access. For Kilburn, use local buses.

There are no planned track works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway or London Tramlank. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Turnham Green and Richmond owing to line improvement at Richmond. Replacement buses will call at: Turnham Green – Chiswick Park – Gunnersbury – Kew Gardens (Victoria Gate) – Richmond.

Northern line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Tooting Broadway and Morden owing to the testing of new signalling. Replacement buses will call at: Tooting Broadway – Colliers Wood – South Wimbledon – Morden.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Wembley Park and Uxbridge owing to track replacement at West Harrow and Ruislip, and drainage renewal at Hillingdon. Trains will run between Aldgate, and Amersham/Chesham/Watford via Harrow-on-the-Hill, but will not stop at Preston Road or Northwick Park. Replacement buses will run: Service A: Wembley Park – Preston Road – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) – Northwick Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill

Service D: Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow (Trevor Avenue) – South Harrow (for eastbound Piccadilly line) – Rayners Lane – Eastcote – Ruislip Manor – Ruislip – West Ruislip (for the Central line and Chiltern Railways) – Ickenham – Hillingdon – Uxbridge

Piccadilly line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between South Harrow and Uxbridge owing to track replacement at Ruislip and drainage renewal at Hillingdon. Replacement buses will call at: Uxbridge – Hillingdon – Ickenham – West Ruislip (for the Central line and National Rail services) – Ruislip – Ruislip Manor – Eastcote – Rayners Lane – South Harrow (for the eastbound Piccadilly line) – West Harrow (Trevor Avenue) – Harrow-on-the-Hill.

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Richmond and Willesden Junction owing to line improvement work at Richmond. Replacement buses will call at: Richmond – Kew Gardens – Gunnersbury – South Acton – Acton Central – Willesden Junction.

Sunday: No service between Clapham Junction and Willesden Junction in preparation for development work in the Earls Court area. Tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: No service between Watford Junction and Queen's Park owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will call at: Watford Junction – Watford High Street – Bushey – Carpenders Park – Hatch End – Headstone Lane – Harrow & Wealdstone. Use the Bakerloo line between Harrow & Wealdstone and Queen's Park.

Sunday: Until 8.15am, no northbound service from Clapham Junction to Wandsworth Road owing to Network Rail track work. The 7.20am and 7.50am trains from Clapham Junction to Highbury & Islington will run on an alternative route, starting from Battersea Park (at 7.22am and 7.52am), calling at Wandsworth Road and then all stations to Highbury & Islington. Southbound services will not be affected. Tickets will be accepted on local buses between Clapham Junction and Battersea Park/Surrey Quays.

Sunday: Until 9.30am and after 9pm, no service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace owing to Network Rail track work. Tickets will be accepted on Southern services between Norwood Junction and Crystal Palace, and on local buses via all reasonable routes.
