

Plan ahead for the weekend

Circle line

Saturday: No service on the entire line until 10.30am. Use alternative Tube services or local bus routes.

All weekend: No service between Euston Square and Monument (via Aldgate) from 10.30am on Saturday and all day on Sunday. Use alternative Tube or local bus services.

District line

Saturday: No service between Embankment and West Ham, and between Edgware Road and High Street Kensington until 10.30am. Use alternative Tube or local bus services. A rail replacement bus service will run between Liverpool Street and Barking until 10.30am.

All weekend: No service between Monument and Stepney Green from 10.30am on Saturday and all day on Sunday. Use alternative Tube or local bus services.

Hammersmith & City line

Saturday: No service on the entire line until 10.30am. Use alternative Tube or local bus services. Until 10.30am, a rail replacement bus service will run between Liverpool Street and Barking.

All weekend: No service between Euston Square and Stepney Green from 10.30am on Saturday and all day on Sunday. Use alternative Tube or local bus services.

Metropolitan line

Saturday: No service between Wembley Park and Aldgate until 10.30am. Use alternative Tube or local bus services.

All weekend: No service between Baker Street and Aldgate from 10.30am on Saturday and all day on Sunday. Use alternative Tube or local bus services.

Piccadilly line

All weekend: Trains will not stop at South Kensington. The Circle and District lines will run as normal, and the station will remain open.

London Overground

All weekend: No service between Willesden Junction and Clapham Junction. Use local bus services instead.

All weekend: No service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell, and between Surrey Quays and New Cross. A replacement bus service will run between Dalston Kingsland and Shadwell. For New Cross, use London Overground services to New Cross Gate, then walk or use local and replacement bus services.

Sunday: No service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction. Use rail replacement bus services instead.

TfL Rail

Sunday: No service between Paddington and Ealing Broadway, and a reduced service will run on the rest of the line. See separate box below for more information.

Reduced night services

THIS weekend, there is no Night Tube or Night Overground service, and limited Night Bus services are running. This includes tonight's night services.

Staying safe when travelling

NATIONAL restrictions to combat the spread of the coronavirus mean everyone must stay at home unless they have a reasonable excuse. Public transport can still be used for such journeys. Londoners should consider using the city's network of safe walking or cycling routes instead, and to use TfL's travel tools to plan journeys by public transport during the quieter times, between 8.15am and 4pm and after 5.30pm on weekdays, and before midday and after 6pm on weekends.

Hospital-grade cleaning substances are being used on trains, trams, buses and at stations, and customers should carry hand sanitiser with them on their journey.

Extensive signage is in place, reminding customers to maintain social distancing. TfL is working with the police to enforce the

national requirement for everyone to wear a face covering over their nose and mouth while in a station or travelling on public transport, unless they are exempt. For the latest advice, visit tfl.gov.uk/coronavirus

Going through Paddington?

THIS Sunday, there will be no TfL Rail, Great Western Railway or Heathrow Express services between London Paddington and Ealing Broadway or Heathrow.

Customers can instead take the Central or District lines to Ealing Broadway, or the Piccadilly line for Heathrow Airport.

For help with an accessible journey, customers should check in advance or go to Paddington and speak to staff at the National Rail station.

Signal upgrade takes next step

FROM tomorrow, the next phase of a major signalling upgrade on the Circle, District, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan lines will be introduced, which could result in some delays to journeys.

TfL has made significant preparations to make sure this complex operation goes smoothly, but there may be delays as the

new system comes into operation, especially on the District line from Monday.

There may be some cancellations and larger gaps between trains, so customers are advised to check before they travel, allow more time and travel at quiet times where possible.

There will also be some early finishes to services on the Circle, District and Hammersmith & City lines at the weekend, owing to staff shortages in the TfL control room. For more information and to help plan your journey, visit tfl.gov.uk
