PLANNING AHEAD

The future of the Tube

MAYOR Boris Johnson and managing director of London Underground Mike Brown have set out their vision for the future of the Tube.

Plans include a new 24-hour 'Night Tube' service at weekends and more staff visible and available at stations to help customers buy the right ticket, plan their journeys and keep them safe and secure.

From 2015, weekend services will run through the night on core parts of the system – initially on the Piccadilly, Victoria, Central and Jubilee lines, and sections of the Northern line. This will include other lines in subsequent years, which will dovetail with existing 24-hour and Night bus services to give passengers an extensive and integrated service throughout the night.

There are no planned track works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Metropolitan, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or London Tramlank. However, the following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works:

Bakerloo line

Station closure

Edgware Road: Closed until late December owing to lift replacement work. Edgware Road (Circle and Hammersmith & City lines) is the nearest alternative station. Trains from here connect with Bakerloo line services at Baker Street and Paddington.

Central line

Station closures

Chancery Lane: Trains will not stop on Sunday owing to station improvement work. Use Holborn station (a 10-minute walk along High Holborn). Alternatively, take any bus from stop F on High Holborn which will take you to Holborn station.

Mile End: Closed for track replacement work all weekend on the District and Hammersmith & City lines. Use local buses from Bethnal Green or the District line replacement buses instead (see below).

District line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Whitechapel and West Ham while track is replaced in the Mile End area. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and Docklands Light Railway). Some early morning and late evening journeys will run to/from Plaistow.

Service B: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for the Jubilee line, DLR, London Overground and Greater Anglia)

Mile End: See Central line entry.

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Moorgate and Barking while track is replaced in the Mile End area. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and Docklands Light Railway). Some early morning and late evening journeys will run to/from Plaistow

Service B: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for the Jubilee line, DLR, London Overground and Greater Anglia)

Mile End: See Central line entry.

Jubilee line

Part closure

Sunday: No service between Waterloo and Finchley Road until 11am owing to tunnelling work. Use alternative Tube or bus services.

Northern line

Part closure

Saturday: No service between Morden and East Finchley/Golders Green via Bank and Charing Cross while new signalling is tested. Replacement bus services will run:

Service B: King's Cross St. Pancras – Camden Town – Kentish Town – Tufnell Park – Archway – Highgate – East Finchley

Service C: Finchley Central – West Finchley – North Finchley (Tally Ho Corner) – Arnos Grove (for the Piccadilly line)

Service E: Euston – Mornington Crescent – Camden Town – Chalk Farm – Belsize Park – Hampstead – Golders Green – Finchley Road (for the Metropolitan and Jubilee lines)

Service H: Clapham Common – Clapham South – Balham (for National Rail to/from Victoria) – Tooting Bec – Tooting Broadway – Colliers Wood – South Wimbledon – Morden

Service J: Elephant & Castle – Kennington – Oval – Stockwell – Clapham North – Clapham Common – Clapham South – Balham (for National Rail services to/from Victoria).

Southbound buses will stop at Tooting Bec

Service X: Wimbledon (for the District line, National Rail services and London Tramlank) – South Wimbledon – Morden

Docklands Light Railway

Part closure

Sunday: No service between Stratford and Bow Church owing to Crossrail work. Replacement buses will call at: Stratford – Pudding Mill Lane – Bow Church.

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Highbury & Islington and New Cross/New Cross Gate owing to track and signalling work. Use services between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland to connect with replacement bus services to/from Dalston Junction:

Service X: Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Aldgate East – Tower Gateway – Bermondsey – Canada Water (for Rotherhithe) – Surrey Quays – New Cross – New Cross Gate

Service W: Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell – Wapping

Tickets will also be accepted on local buses and Tubes via all reasonable routes – be aware that tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford.

All weekend: No service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction owing to track and signalling work. Replacement buses will call at: Canada Water – Surrey Quays – Queens Road Peckham – Peckham Rye – Denmark Hill – Clapham High Street – Wandsworth.

Saturday: No service between New Cross Gate and Crystal Palace/West Croydon owing to track and signalling work. Use Southern services between these stations.

Sunday: No service between New Cross Gate and Crystal Palace/West Croydon owing to track and signalling work and Network Rail track and electrical work. Replacement buses will call at: New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Park – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon.
