More gates for Moorgate

AS part of the Tube improvement plan, the ticket halls at Moorgate Tube station are being improved and enlarged, starting with the area that serves the Northern line.

Work will begin on Monday to remove the ticket gates and install temporary Oyster validators. Oyster card users are advised to use these validators to touch in and out to ensure they pay the correct fare.

The work is expected to take around three weeks.



Battersea Park London Overground closure reminder

THERE is no weekday London Overground service between Wandsworth Road and Battersea Park until October 11 owing to Network Rail track work.

The 6.18am service that usually runs from Battersea Park to Highbury & Islington will instead start from Clapham Junction at 6.16am.

The 10.17pm service from Highbury & Islington that usually terminates at Battersea Park will finish at Clapham Junction instead.

Overground tickets will be accepted on Southern rail services between Battersea Park and Clapham Junction during the works.

Update – lifts at Hammersmith

WORK started in May to replace both lifts at Hammersmith Tube station. Replacing lifts is a huge task with much of it taking place off site to produce bespoke parts.

The project is expected to be completed before the Christmas period – a little earlier than originally planned.

Tube improvements on track

A NEW campaign is highlighting how Tube improvements show that every journey matters to Transport for London.

Launching today, it features posters, press adverts and articles, social media, online banners, leaflets, films and radio. Network-wide, messaging highlights how delays have been cut and wi-fi is being made available to customers.

There are no planned track works on the Bakerloo, Circle, District, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee, Metropolitan, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway or London Tramlink. However, the following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Bakerloo line

Station closures

Edgware Road: Closed all weekend until late December owing to lift replacement work. Edgware Road (Circle and Hammersmith & City lines) is the nearest alternative station. Trains from here connect with Bakerloo line services at Baker Street and Paddington.

Maida Vale: Closed between 8am and 2pm on Sunday owing to work to fix a power supply fault. During this time, use local bus services to continue your journey. To travel from Maida Vale to the Bakerloo line towards central London, use bus route 332 from stop B on Maida Vale and change at Paddington. To travel from Maida Vale to the Bakerloo line towards Harrow & Wealdstone, use bus route 187 from stop D on Hall Road and change at Warwick Avenue.

Central line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Bethnal Green and Loughton/Hainault (via Newbury Park). On Sunday, the closure will be extended to Liverpool Street until 8am. This is while drainage is replaced in the Leytonstone area, and to carry out station improvement work at Buckhurst Hill.

For journeys to/from central London, you may find it faster to travel via Chingford, Ilford or Walthamstow Central for the Victoria line or National Rail. Replacement buses will run:

Service A: Hainault – Fairlop – Fullwell Cross – Barkingside – Newbury Park – Ilford (for Greater Anglia rail services)

Service B: Newbury Park – Gants Hill – Redbridge – Wanstead – Snaresbrook – Walthamstow Central (for the Victoria line and Greater Anglia rail services)

Service C: Loughton – Buckhurst Hill – Woodford – South Woodford – Snaresbrook – Leytonstone – Leyton – Stratford (for the Jubilee line, Docklands Light Railway and Greater Anglia rail services)

Service E: Woodford – South Woodford – Snaresbrook – Walthamstow Central (for the Victoria line and Greater Anglia rail services)

Service F: Loughton – Chingford (for Greater Anglia rail services)

Northern line

Part closure

Sunday: No service between Camden Town and Edgware before 8.30am southbound, and 9am northbound, owing to new signalling testing. Bus route N5 will call at all affected Northern line stations, except Brent Cross, until services resume.

London Overground

Part closure

Sunday: No service between Willesden Junction and Camden Road via West Hampstead owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will call at: Willesden Junction – Kensal Rise – Brondesbury Park – Brondesbury – West Hampstead – Finchley Road Tube (for Finchley Road & Frognal) – Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (bus stops at the station) – Kentish Town West (bus stops in Kentish Town Road) – Camden Road.

Trains will run from Willesden Junction, calling at Kensal Green, Queen's Park, Kilburn High Road, South Hampstead, then Camden Road and all stations to Stratford.

Sunday: No service between South Tottenham and Barking until midday owing to Network Rail bridge work. Replacement buses will call at: South Tottenham – Blackhorse Road – Walthamstow Queen's Road – Walthamstow Central – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – Barking
