

Will your journey be affected this weekend?

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Jubilee, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, DLR or London Trams. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Circle line

Full closure

All weekend: no service on the line owing to station improvement work at Moorgate, Barbican and Liverpool Street, and track replacement at Aldgate. Use alternative Tube and/or bus services.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Tower Hill and Barking owing to track replacement at Aldgate East and Plaistow, Crossrail construction work at Whitechapel, and station improvements at Stepney Green. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for other TfL services) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking.

Service B: Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the DLR and Jubilee line) – Plaistow – Stratford (for other TfL services).

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between King's Cross St. Pancras and Barking owing to track replacement at Aldgate East and Plaistow, Crossrail construction work at Whitechapel, and station improvements at Stepney Green. See the District line entry for replacement bus details.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between King's Cross St. Pancras and Aldgate owing to station improvement work at Moorgate, Barbican and Liverpool Street, and track replacement at Aldgate. Use alternative Tube and/or bus services.

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Shepherd's Bush and Willesden Junction owing to Network Rail infrastructure work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

All weekend: no service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell owing to Crossrail construction work. Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland or local buses between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Junction via all reasonable routes. Replacement buses will run between Dalston Kingsland and Shadwell. Alternatively, use Tube services via all reasonable routes (entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only).

All weekend: no service between Gospel Oak and Barking owing to Network Rail work to enable new, longer trains to run from 2018. Replacement bus services will run between Gospel Oak and Seven Sisters (for South Tottenham), and between Walthamstow Central and Barking. (At East Ham, eastbound buses will set down only and westbound buses will pick up only.) Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road. Use Tube services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central.

Saturday: no service between Surrey Quays and New Cross owing to Crossrail construction work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes or use New Cross Gate for connecting trains via Surrey Quays.

Sunday: no service between New Cross Gate and Crystal Palace/West Croydon owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will run between New Cross Gate and West Croydon.

Passengers should also be aware that the line is closed between South Tottenham and Barking on weekdays.

TfL Rail

Part closure

Sunday until 8.30am: no service between Liverpool Street and Shenfield owing to Network Rail carrying out overhead power and track works. Replacement buses will run between Liverpool Street and Shenfield (not calling at Maryland).

Travel with Pride

PRIDE in London takes place tomorrow with a number of events and celebrations, including the Pride Parade, Soho Party and a rally in Trafalgar Square.

The parade will start on Portland Place at 1pm and run through Regent Street, Piccadilly Circus, Pall Mall and Trafalgar Square before finishing at Whitehall Place.

Traffic disruption is likely on the A501 to the north, Park Lane and the A4 to the west and on Victoria Embankment and Waterloo Bridge to the south. Drivers are advised to find alternative routes and avoid the areas as road closures and diversions will be in place.

Buses in the area will be diverted or stopping short of their destinations on Saturday between 9am and 8pm.

The best way to travel around central London will be by Tube and rail, although St. James' Park, Westminster, Oxford Circus, Piccadilly Circus, Charing Cross and Embankment Tube stations may be busier than usual.
