IMPROVEMENTS UNDER WAY

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or Docklands Light Railway. The following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Aldgate East and Bromley-by-Bow owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel. Replacement buses will call at: Tower Hill – Aldgate – Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and DLR).

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Liverpool Street and Barking owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel. Trains will divert to/from Aldgate. See the District line entry for replacement bus information.

Jubilee line

Part closure

Saturday: no service between Willesden Green and Stanmore while points are renewed and track replaced at Neasden. Replacement buses will call at: Willesden Green – Dollis Hill – Neasden – Wembley Park – Kingsbury – Queensbury – Canons Park (Honeypot Lane) – Stanmore

Sunday: Saturday's closure will extend to West Hampstead. Replacement bus services: Service D: Finchley Road – West Hampstead (southbound only) – Kilburn – Willesden Green – Dollis Hill – Neasden – Wembley Park

Service C: Stonebridge Park (for Bakerloo line and London Overground) – Wembley Park – Kingsbury – Queensbury – Canons Park (Honeypot Lane) – Stanmore

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Aldgate and Harrow-on-the-Hill to allow for points work and track replacement at Neasden. Additional Chiltern Railways trains will run between Marylebone and Harrow-on-the-Hill. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: Wembley Park – Preston Road – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) – Northwick Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Highbury & Islington and New Cross/Clapham Junction/Crystal Palace/West Croydon owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel and preparing the network for five-car trains. Use London Overground trains or local buses between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland for connecting replacement buses to New Cross/New Cross Gate. Replacement buses will also run between Canada Water and Clapham Junction. Use DLR services between Deptford Bridge and Shadwell or Tube services via all reasonable routes (for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only). On Saturday, use Southern services between New Cross Gate and West Croydon, and between Sydenham and Crystal Palace. On Sunday, use local buses via all reasonable routes between Sydenham and Crystal Palace. Use Southern services between Norwood Junction and Crystal Palace, and between New Cross Gate and West Croydon.

TfL Rail

Part closure

Sunday: no service between Shenfield and Gidea Park owing to Network Rail infrastructure work. Use alternative Abellio Greater Anglia services or the replacement buses which will call at: Gidea Park – Harold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield.

London Trams

Part closure

All weekend: until October, no service between Wimbledon and Dundonald Road owing to platform construction work that will help increase capacity. Trams start and terminate at Dundonald Road, which is around a ten-minute walk to/from Wimbledon station. Local buses connect Wimbledon with London Trams at the following stops: Merton Park – Wimbledon (163 and 164); Morden Road – Wimbledon (93); and Phipps Bridge – Wimbledon (200). Tram tickets will be accepted on these buses.

All weekend: until Friday July 31, no service between New Addington and Sandilands owing to track replacement. Replacement buses will run. Go to tfl.gov.uk for full details.

Step-free changes at Finchley Central

FROM Monday, there will be no step-free access to the southbound Northern line (platform 3) at Finchley Central Tube station.

Access to platform 3 will be via the stairs only. Step-free access to the northbound Northern line towards High Barnet and Mill Hill East will remain.

For step-free access to the southbound Northern line, customers should take lift 2

to platforms 1 and 2 for the northbound Northern line and a train to High Barnet or Mill Hill East for a southbound Northern line train. Customers at High Barnet requiring step-free access to exit at Finchley Central should take a southbound train to Highgate then take a northbound train to Finchley Central. These changes will remain in place until mid-September while maintenance work is carried out on a lift.

Whitechapel station prepares for Crossrail

WHITECHAPEL station will be closed this weekend as work is carried out to prepare it for the arrival of Crossrail services.

A significant amount of work has already taken place to rebuild the station and create new tunnels for Crossrail, but while much of it hasn't caused disruption to the London Overground, some service suspensions are now needed to install a new concourse directly above the tracks. This will mean services on parts of the line will not run from tomorrow until Tuesday (see below).

London Overground services next week

ON Monday and Tuesday next week, there will be no service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel. Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland or local buses via all reasonable routes. Replacement buses will run between Dalston Kingsland and Shadwell. Use Tube services via all reasonable routes (for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only). There will also be no service between Surrey Quays and New Cross owing to Crossrail work. Rail replacement buses will run.

Victoria line closure next month

TO make further improvements to the Victoria line, between August 8 and 30 there will be no service between Seven Sisters and Walthamstow Central while major engineering work takes place.
