

## Will your journey be affected this weekend?

There are no planned works on the Circle, Hammersmith & City, Metropolitan, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway or London Tramlink. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

### Bakerloo line

#### Part closure

**Sunday:** No service between Queen's Park and Harrow & Wealdstone owing to Network Rail engineering work. Replacement buses will call at: Queen's Park – Kensal Green – Willesden Junction – Harlesden – Stonebridge Park – Wembley Central – North Wembley – Preston Road (for the Metropolitan line and South Kenton) – Kenton – Harrow & Wealdstone

### Central line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between White City and Ealing Broadway/West Ruislip owing to track replacement at North Acton. Replacement bus services will run:  
Service A: White City – East Acton – North Acton – West Acton – Ealing Broadway  
Service B: White City – North Acton – Northolt – South Ruislip – Ruislip Gardens – West Ruislip  
Service C: White City – North Acton – Park Royal (for the Piccadilly line) – Hanger Lane – Perivale – Greenford (for National Rail services to/from Paddington on Saturday) – Northolt

### District line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Barking and Upminster, or between Turnham Green and Richmond, owing to line improvement work. Replacement bus services will run:  
Service A: Turnham Green – Chiswick Park – Gunnersbury – Royal Botanical Gardens (Victoria Gate) – Richmond  
Service B: Barking – Upney – Becontree – Dagenham Heathway – Dagenham East  
Service C: Barking – Dagenham East – Elm Park – Hornchurch – Upminster Bridge – Upminster

### Jubilee line

#### Part closure

**Sunday:** No service between Waterloo and Finchley Road until 11am owing to tunnel lining work. Use alternative bus and/or Tube services.

### London Overground

#### Part closure

**Saturday:** No service between Richmond and Willesden Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will run:  
**Sunday:** No service between Richmond and Camden Road while work is carried out to prepare the network for five-car trains. Replacement buses will run.  
**Sunday:** No service between Watford Junction and Queen's Park owing to platform extension work at Willesden Junction. Replacement bus services will run.

## Saturday road closures around Westminster

A TUC march and rally will take place in the Westminster area on Saturday. The march will start at Temple Place and make its way via Victoria Embankment, Northumberland Avenue, Trafalgar Square, Cockspur Street, Regent Street,

Piccadilly, Hyde Park Corner to Park Lane and through the Queen Mother's Gate into Hyde Park for the rally.

There will be a number of road closures in place so traffic disruption is likely in the City of London, south of the river, to the north as far as the A501 Marylebone Road and to the west of Hyde Park Corner. Road users are advised to avoid these areas if possible or allow extra time to travel.

## Kennington lift work

KENNINGTON station will have a reduced lift service from Monday until late November while maintenance work takes place. To avoid queues and delays, customers are advised to use nearby Oval or Elephant & Castle stations for the Northern line. Both stations are around a 10-minute walk from Kennington, and buses are also available.

## Gloucester Road update

PICCADILLY line trains will stop at Gloucester Road station once again from mid-December. Trains have not been stopping at the station since May while two lifts are being replaced. Some work still needs to be done on the lighting and connection of electrical equipment. Once this is completed, in the next few weeks, an intensive programme of testing will be the final task before the lifts are brought back into service.
