Deck out your tree with a transport-themed Christmas decoration for £15. Choose from a knitted London Tube train, a bus or taxi.

Alternatively you can add character to your spruce with a sustainable, bamboo London Underground roundel decorated in different patterns for £6.

3. WINTER WARMERS

Look stylish this season in one of these Christmas jumpers, available in both adult and children's sizes. The adult jumper has a pattern of bicycles, Tube trains, red buses, snowflakes, roundels and Santas, retailing at £38. The sizes range from XX-Small, to XX-Large.

There's also a beautiful blue children's jumper, in the same design. Retailing at £25, it is available in sizes three to 12 years.

Planned bus strikes this week

CUSTOMERS are advised to check ahead for planned strikes on Abellio and Metrolink bus services.

Abellio strikes will affect routes in west and south London and Metrolink strikes will affect routes in west, north-west and north London. The strikes will take place on certain routes tomorrow, Friday and

Saturday, as well as December 8, 9, 10, 15, 16 and 17. On the days after the strikes, a good service will be running by about 6am.

Customers are advised to plan ahead and consider alternative options. To find out which routes are affected each day, visit tfl.gov.uk/strikes
