

## Will your journey be affected this weekend?

### Works at Holborn

FROM Tuesday August 13 to Friday August 23, there will be no access to the Piccadilly line at Holborn Tube station during peak time weekday mornings.

Between 8am and 10am, passengers will not be able to access the Piccadilly line from street level or change onto it from the Central line. This is so brake maintenance work can take place as part of the Tube improvement plan.

Access to the Central line will not be affected and customers arriving at Holborn on the Piccadilly line will be able

to exit and interchange as usual.

Piccadilly line passengers who start their journey at Holborn are being advised to use nearby Russell Square instead. Passengers who normally change from the Central line onto the Piccadilly line should use alternative Tube and local bus routes.

There are no planned track works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Jubilee, Metropolitan, Northern, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or London Tramlank. However, the following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

#### Bakerloo line

#### Station closure

**Edgware Road:** Closed until late December owing to lift replacement work. Edgware Road (Circle and Hammersmith & City lines) is the nearest alternative station. Trains from here connect with Bakerloo line services at Baker Street and Paddington.

#### Central line

#### Station closure

**Mile End:** Closed all weekend owing to track replacement work on the District and Hammersmith & City lines. Customers are advised to use the District line replacement buses then change to Circle and Metropolitan line train services at Aldgate, or use alternative local bus or Tube services.

#### District line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Tower Hill and West Ham owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel and track replacement at Mile End. Replacement buses will call at:

- Tower Hill – Aldgate – Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and Docklands Light Railway)

#### Hammersmith & City line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Moorgate and Barking owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel and track replacement in the Mile End area. Replacement buses will call at:

- Tower Hill – Aldgate – Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and Docklands Light Railway)

#### Piccadilly line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between King's Cross St. Pancras and Hammersmith owing to points work at Hyde Park Corner and Holborn.

#### Docklands Light Railway

#### Part closure

**Sunday:** No service between Stratford and Bow Church owing to Crossrail station work. Replacement bus services will call at:

- Stratford – Pudding Mill – Bow Church. Buses will run every 10 minutes between 6.30am and midnight

#### London Overground

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between South Tottenham and Barking owing to Network Rail track renewal work. Replacement buses will call at:

- South Tottenham – Blackhorse Road – Walthamstow Queen's Road – Walthamstow Central – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – Barking

**All weekend:** No service between Clapham Junction and Kensington Olympia owing to Network Rail bridge and platform extension work. Tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

**Sunday:** Until 8am, no service between Highbury & Islington and New Cross Gate owing to Network Rail track work. Tickets will be accepted on local bus routes via all reasonable routes.

**Sunday:** Until 9.15am, no service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Tickets will be accepted on local bus routes via all reasonable routes.

**Sunday:** No service between New Cross Gate and West Croydon owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will call at:

- New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Park – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (also for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon

**Sunday:** No service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will call at:

- New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Park – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon
