The Minutes of the Finance Committee Meeting held on December 4<sup>th</sup> were read and signed as correct by the Chairman.

The Solicitor reported that he had obtained Counsel's opinion on the question of the cancellation of the Option referred to under Clause 11 of the Agreement dated April 7<sup>th</sup> 1908 (referred to at the previous Finance Committee Meeting) and submitted draft Agreement which was referred to the Underground Board for consideration.

The Solicitor further reported that he had obtained Counsel's opinion on the question of the payment of dividends (during reconstruction of the Railway) on the Preference Stock of the City and South London Railway and after some discussion it was decided that the whole matter should be allowed to remain over until after the first of the year.
