Night Tube Service

2

weeks to go until the Jubilee line joins the Night Tube network

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Jubilee, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, DLR, or London Trams. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Circle line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Hammersmith and Tower Hill (via King's Cross St. Pancras). This is for Crossrail construction work at Moorgate, Barbican and Liverpool Street, and track replacement work at Farringdon. Use the Hammersmith & City line between King's Cross St. Pancras and Hammersmith. A Circle line service will run between Edgware Road and Barking (via Victoria).

District line

Part closure

Sunday: no service between Turnham Green and Richmond. This is while Network Rail carries out track improvement work. Replacement buses will call at: Turnham Green - Chiswick Park - Gunnersbury - Royal Botanic Gardens - Richmond.

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between King's Cross St. Pancras and Barking for Crossrail construction work at Moorgate, Barbican and Liverpool Street, and track replacement work at Farringdon. Use alternative bus and/or Tube routes.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between King's Cross St. Pancras and Aldgate. This is for Crossrail construction work at Moorgate, Barbican and Liverpool Street, and track replacement work at Farringdon. Use alternative bus and/or Tube routes.

Closure of Gospel Oak to Barking line from tomorrow

THE London Overground line between Gospel Oak and Barking will close from tomorrow until February next year. This is while Network Rail carries out upgrade work.

Replacement bus services will be available for parts of the journey and customers are advised to plan ahead - see the London Overground entry on this page for alternative travel information.

Regular pay as you go users of the line will be automatically refunded the additional cost of travel via Zone 1 by Tube or rail.

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Liverpool Street and Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters) Walthamstow Central owing to Network Rail track work. Use Abellio Greater Anglia services between Liverpool Street and Cheshunt (via Tottenham Hale). Use local buses between Liverpool Street and Seven Sisters via all reasonable routes or Tube via all reasonable routes (entrance/exit at Liverpool Street, Seven Sisters, Tottenham Hale and Walthamstow Central stations only). Replacement bus services will run between Seven Sisters and Enfield Town, between Seven Sisters and Cheshunt, and between Hackney Downs and Walthamstow Central.

All weekend: no service between Romford and Upminster owing to Crossrail and Network Rail infrastructure work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: no service between Richmond and Camden Road (via West Hampstead) owing to Network Rail track and infrastructure work. Replacement buses between Richmond and Willesden Junction, and between Willesden Junction and Camden Road. Trains will run along an alternative route between Willesden Junction and Stratford.

Until February: no service between Gospel Oak and Barking. This is while Network Rail carries out work to enable longer trains to run from 2018, which will double capacity on the route. Replacement buses will run between Gospel Oak and Seven Sisters (for South Tottenham), and between Walthamstow Central and Barking. At East Ham, eastbound buses will set down only and westbound buses will pick up only. Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road. Use Tube services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central, and between East Ham and Barking.

Between Monday and Thursday next week, there will be no service between Hackney Downs and Chingford after 10.30pm. Replacement buses will run.

TfL Rail

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Stratford and Shenfield. This is while Network Rail carries out track and station improvements, as well as Crossrail construction work. Replacement bus services will run:

- Romford - Chadwell Heath - Goodmayes - Seven Kings - Ilford - Manor Park - Forest Gate - Stratford
- Shenfield - Brentwood - Harold Wood - Gidea Park - Romford - Chadwell Heath - Newbury Park (for the Central line)

Owing to a football match at London Stadium in Stratford, on Sunday replacement buses, and West Ham, Stratford and Newbury Park stations, are expected to be busy between 12.30pm and 7.30pm. Allow more time for your journey.

Go behind the scenes

THE London Transport Museum Depot in Acton will open its doors this weekend to celebrate the capital's most iconic logo, the roundel.

Visitors can discover how the symbol, which was voted a transport design icon by Londoners, has become recognisable around the world.

There will also be themed arts and crafts activities, a scavenger hunt, talks, curator-led tours, and a chance to print your own roundel canvas tote bag to take home.
