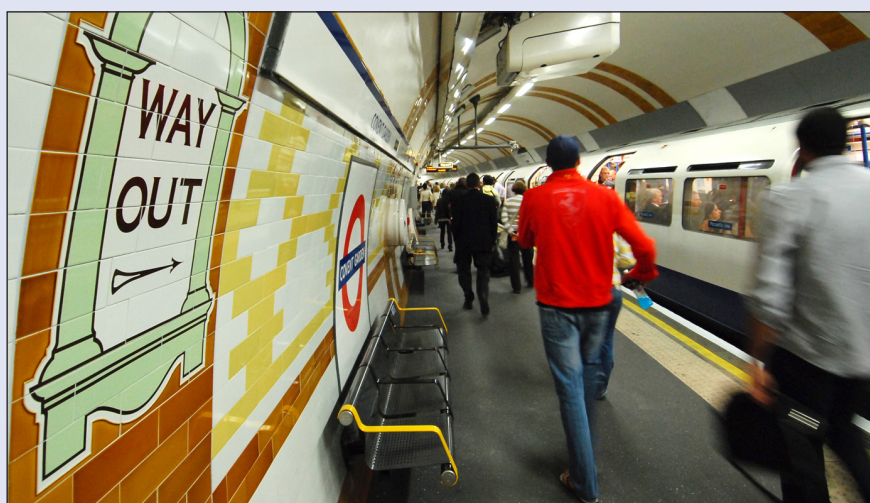

### Covent Garden to become exit-only during works



FROM Monday, Covent Garden station will be exit-only, and westbound Piccadilly line trains will not stop at weekends, while work is undertaken to replace four lifts.

Customers are advised to use Leicester Square which is a short, signposted walk from Covent Garden.

When the new, more spacious and faster lifts enter service they will increase capacity by 25 per cent.

Work on the first two lifts will last for around ten months, but will stop during the Christmas period. The replacement of the

other two will start in February next year.

The project involves engineers removing the existing lift cars and replacing all of the structural, mechanical and electrical parts.

Phil Hufton, chief operating officer for London Underground, said: 'It has been around 25 years since the existing lifts were installed so it's time for them to be replaced so that they can operate more efficiently, quickly and reliably for customers. We have explored various options to carry out these works while keeping disruption to a minimum.'

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, District, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or London Tramlank. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

#### Metropolitan line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Wembley Park and Northwood/Uxbridge owing to track replacement at Northwick Park and Rayners Lane. A fast service will continue to run between Harrow-on-the-Hill and Amersham, and additional Chiltern Railways services will run between Harrow-on-the-Hill and Marylebone. Replacement bus services will also run:

Service A: Wembley Park – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow (Trevor Avenue) – South Harrow (for the Piccadilly line) – Rayners Lane – Eastcote – Ruislip Manor – Ruislip – West Ruislip (for the Central line and National Rail) – Ickenham – Hillingdon – Uxbridge

Service B: Wembley Park – Preston Road – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) – Northwick Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow (Pinner Road) – North Harrow – Pinner – Northwood Hills – Northwood

#### Northern line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Camden Town and Edgware while new signalling is tested. Replacement bus services will run:

Service D: Finchley Road (for the Jubilee and Metropolitan lines) – Golders Green – Hendon Central – Colindale – Burnt Oak – Edgware – Canons Park (for the Jubilee line)

Service E: Camden Town – Chalk Farm – Belsize Park – Hampstead – Golders Green – Brent Cross – Hendon Central

#### Piccadilly line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between South Harrow and Uxbridge owing to track replacement at Rayners Lane and drainage renewal at Hillingdon. Replacement buses will call at: Wembley Park – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow (Trevor Avenue) – South Harrow – Rayners Lane – Eastcote – Ruislip Manor – Ruislip – West Ruislip (for the Central line and National Rail) – Ickenham – Hillingdon – Uxbridge

#### Docklands Light Railway

#### Part closure

**From 11pm Saturday and all day Sunday:** No service between Stratford and Bow Church owing to Crossrail work at Pudding Mill Lane. Replacement buses will call at: Stratford – Pudding Mill Lane – Bow Church.

#### London Overground

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Richmond and Camden Road via West Hampstead. On Saturday, Network Rail track work will take place. And on Sunday, work to improve signalling and track layout to prepare the line for five-car trains will be carried out. Use the District line between Richmond and Gunnersbury. Replacement buses will call at: Gunnersbury – South Acton – Acton Central – Willesden Junction – Kensal Rise – Brondesbury Park – Brondesbury – West Hampstead – Finchley Road (for Finchley Road & Frognal) – Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (bus stops at station) – Kentish Town West (bus stops in Kentish Town Road) – Camden Road. Trains will run to an amended timetable along an alternative route between Willesden Junction (low-level platforms) and Stratford, calling at Kensal Green, Queen's Park, Kilburn High Road, South Hampstead, Camden Road and all stations to/from Stratford.

**Saturday:** No service between Shepherd's Bush and Willesden Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

**Sunday:** No service between Clapham Junction and Willesden Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes and on Southern services between Clapham Junction and Shepherd's Bush.

**Sunday:** No service between Highbury & Islington and Clapham Junction/New Cross/ New Cross Gate owing to work to improve signalling and track layout to prepare the line for five-car trains. Use trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland to connect with replacement buses to/from Dalston Junction. Replacement bus services will run:

Service X: Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Aldgate East – Tower Gateway – Bermondsey – Canada Water (for Rotherhithe) – Surrey Quays – Deptford Bridge – New Cross – New Cross Gate

Service W: Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell – Wapping

Service M: Canada Water – Surrey Quays – Queens Road Peckham – Peckham Rye – Denmark Hill – Clapham High Street – Wandsworth Road – Clapham Junction

Tickets will also be accepted on local buses and Tube services via all reasonable routes (tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations), and on DLR services between Stratford/Shadwell and Deptford Bridge.

**Sunday:** No service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace owing to work to improve signalling and track layout to prepare the line for five-car trains. Tickets will be accepted on Southern services between Norwood Junction and Crystal Palace, and on local buses via all reasonable routes.
