

Christmas travel information

Plan your festive trips and avoid disruption. Here is a summary of travel information up to and including Boxing Day.

Monday December 22

Normal service on all Tube lines and DLR services. The District line will run between Kensington (Olympia) and Earl's Court 9.50am-11pm.

Normal London Overground service on most lines, however there is an amended timetable will run between Highbury & Islington and West Croydon/Clapham Junction.

No service between Surrey Quays and New Cross. Replacement buses will run.

Tuesday December 23

Normal service on all Tube lines and DLR services. The District line will run between Kensington (Olympia) and Earl's Court 7.40pm-11pm.

Normal London Overground service on most lines, however no service between Clapham Junction and Kensington (Olympia) after 7.30pm. Replacement buses will run between Clapham Junction/Earl's Court (Tube)/Kensington (Olympia) and Shepherd's Bush. Between Kensington (Olympia) and Willesden Junction, an amended timetable will operate after 7.30pm. There will also be an amended timetable between Highbury & Islington and Clapham Junction/

Crystal Palace and West Croydon. No service between Surrey Quays and New Cross. Replacement buses will run.

Christmas Eve

Normal service on all Tube lines, with services reduced after 5pm. The last trains will run earlier, on a Sunday timetable, except for the Waterloo & City line. The District line will operate between Kensington (Olympia) and Earl's Court 6.45am-11.50pm.

For London Overground, check the TfL website for earlier last train times and replacement bus services. No service between Surrey Quays and New Cross, or between Clapham Junction and Kensington (Olympia). Replacement buses will run.

Normal service on the DLR until 4pm, then off-peak service until 7.30pm and an evening service until the last train at 11pm.

Christmas Day

No services but Cycle Hire bikes will be available.

Boxing Day

Tube

Circle line: No service between Edgware Road and Aldgate (via Victoria). Services between Hammersmith and Aldgate will run between 10.30am and 8.30pm.

District line: No service between Edgware Road/Embankment and Ealing Common/Kensington (Olympia)/Richmond/Wimbledon. Replacement buses will run, plus a District line train shuttle between Ealing Broadway and Ealing Common. Some Piccadilly line trains will stop additionally at Ravenscourt

Park, Stamford Brook, Turnham Green and Chiswick Park.

Jubilee line: No service between Waterloo and Finchley Road. Use the Metropolitan line between Wembley Park and Baker Street, the Bakerloo line between Baker Street and Waterloo, and local buses or the replacement bus service between Finchley Road and Baker Street.

Piccadilly line: Sunday service will operate from around 8.30am. Reduced service to Heathrow Terminal 4. A Sunday service will operate on all other lines from around 8.30am.

Travel advice for the Chelsea v West Ham match at Stamford Bridge: Walk to/from Earl's Court, South Kensington or Hammersmith for the Piccadilly line, or Hammersmith & City line for trains to central London.

London Overground

No service.

DLR

Ten-minute service on all routes except between Tower Gateway and Beckton where trains will be diverted to Canary Wharf, and between Stratford International and Beckton where services will terminate at Canning Town. Replacement buses will run.

Update for Bond Street

The Tube station opens fully today so you can now enter, alight and change with Central and Jubilee trains. With Oxford Street busy at this time of year, customers could use Bond Street, Tottenham Court Road or Marble Arch stations as well as Oxford Circus. The latest phase of improvement work was completed ahead of schedule.



There are no planned Tube, DLR or London Tramlink works this weekend. However, on London Overground there is no service on Sunday between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction until 12.30pm owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will run. Go to tfl.gov.uk for full details.
