

**Minutes**

of a Meeting of the **Board of Directors of the Underground Electric Railways Company of London, Limited**, held at the office of the Company on Tuesday June 17<sup>th</sup> 1902, at 3. p.m.

The Secretary read the minutes of the meeting held June 9<sup>th</sup> which were approved.

- 15 It was reported that the code word "**Underneath**" **London** had been obtained as the registered cable and telegraphic address of this Company.
- 16 The Chairman stated that the draft agreement between the Metropolitan District Electric Traction Company Ltd and this Company was still subject to a few slight alterations and would probably be presented at the next meeting of this Board for their consideration.
- 17 The Secretary read a letter from R.T. Wreathall, dated June 13<sup>th</sup> regarding land at Alperton to be used for a temporary power station to operate the Ealing & South Harrow branch of the Metropolitan District Railway, which was referred to the Works Committee.
- 18 The Secretary presented a draft agreement of the Electrical Power Storage Company for storage batteries for a temporary power house at Alperton which was referred to the Works Committee.

19 The Secretary presented a form of agreement between the Governor and Company of Chelsea Water Works for temporary supply of water at the power house site at Chelsea. And it was **Resolved** That the same be signed.
