IMPROVEMENTS UNDER WAY

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Hammersmith & City, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway, London Trams or TfL Rail. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

District line Station closure

All weekend: Whitechapel station will be closed for Crossrail work. Use local buses to Aldgate East or Stepney Green stations.

Hammersmith & City line Station closure

All weekend: Whitechapel station will be closed for Crossrail work. Use local buses to Aldgate East or Stepney Green stations.

Jubilee line Part closure

All weekend: no service between Waterloo and Stanmore owing to track replacement and drainage work at Finchley Road and Wembley Park. Replacement buses will run:

Service C: Stonebridge Park (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) - Wembley Park - Kingsbury - Queensbury - Canons Park (Honeygot Lane) - Stanmore

Service D: Baker Street - St John's Wood - Swiss Cottage - Finchley Road - West Hampstead - Kilburn - Willesden Green - Dollis Hill - Neasden - Wembley Park

Metropolitan line Part closure

All weekend: no service between Aldgate and Harrow-on-the-Hill owing to track replacement and drainage work at Finchley Road and Wembley Park. Extra Chiltern Railways trains will run between Harrow-on-the-Hill and Marylebone. Replacement buses will also run:

Service A: Harrow-on-the-Hill - Northwick Park - Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) - Preston Road - Wembley Park

London Overground Part closure

All weekend: trains will not stop at Whitechapel station owing to Crossrail works. Use local buses.

Sunday: no service between Richmond and Willesden Junction until midday owing to Network Rail track work. Use the District line between Richmond and Gunnersbury. Replacement buses will run between Gunnersbury and Willesden Junction.

Sunday: no service between Gospel Oak and Barking until midday while preparatory works for electrification are carried out. Replacement buses will call at stations.

Sunday: no service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace. A replacement bus service will operate from Crystal Palace to West Croydon.

Accessibility changes at Golders Green and Acton Town stations

Golders Green

THERE will be no step-free access to or from the northbound platform at Golders Green Tube station from Monday until late February. This is so maintenance work can be carried out on the lift. Customers are advised to use Hendon Central station instead.

Acton Town

There will be no step-free access to the westbound District and Piccadilly lines at

Acton Town station from Monday until late February. This is while essential maintenance is carried out on the westbound lift. Access to the westbound platforms will be via the stairs only. Westbound customers requiring step-free access to/from the Acton Town area will need to use the facilities at Hammersmith station. Alternatively, use bus routes 266 and/or E3.

Once this work is finished, work will start on the eastbound lift from late February until mid-April.

Preparing Whitechapel for Crossrail

WHITECHAPEL station will be closed this weekend as work continues to prepare it for TfL-run Crossrail services starting in 2018. From Monday, a new temporary station entrance will be located a short distance away on the corner of Durward Street and Court Street. Once completed, the new station will be made step-free, the ticket hall will be expanded and the new Crossrail platforms will be integrated with the existing Tube and London Overground services. Improvements will also be made to the area around the station. A pedestrian crossing on Whitechapel Road has been relocated closer to the temporary station entrance to give customers better access and bus stops are just a short distance down Whitechapel Road. Court



Street will be pedestrianised and Cycle Superhighway 2 is also being upgraded and is due to be completed in the spring.
