

Plan your weekend travel

Find out about line closures and alternative travel options at tfl.gov.uk

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Jubilee, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria, and Waterloo & City lines. There are also no planned works on the DLR or London Trams. However, engineering and improvement work will affect the following services:

Circle line

Full closure

All weekend: no service throughout the line for modernisation work. Use local buses or other Tube routes instead.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between High Street Kensington and Edgware Road. Use local buses instead.

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Hammersmith and Moorgate. Use other Tube routes instead.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Wembley Park and Aldgate. Use Jubilee line services between Wembley Park and Baker Street, or Chiltern Railways services between Marylebone and Harrow-on-the-Hill.

TfL Rail

Full closure

All weekend: no service between Liverpool Street and Shenfield for engineering works. Use Central line services between Liverpool Street and Newbury Park.

Rail replacement buses will run:

- Service C: Stratford City – Forest Gate (Romford Road) – Manor Park (Romford Road) – Ilford – Seven Kings – Goodmayes – Chadwell Heath (Wangey Road) – Romford
- Service D: Newbury Park (for Central line) – Romford – Gidea Park – Harold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield

Service D will not call at Chadwell Heath owing to roadworks.

London Overground

Part closure

Gospel Oak to Barking route

Sunday: no service between South Tottenham and Barking until 12.45pm, owing to Network Rail track work.

Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road. Use London Underground services between Seven Sisters and Walthamstow Central, and also between East Ham and Barking.

Rail replacement buses will run:

- Walthamstow Central – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road (bus stops at Harrow Green) – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – East Ham – Barking

At East Ham, eastbound buses will stop to set down only and westbound buses will stop to pick up only.

Liverpool Street to Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters)/Chingford route

Saturday: no service between Hackney Downs and Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters) for Network Rail station and infrastructure work. Chingford line trains will call additionally at Cambridge Heath and London Fields.

Use replacement buses between Seven Sisters and Enfield Town/Cheshunt, as below.

Sunday: no service between Liverpool Street and Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters).

Use local buses or London Underground services between Liverpool Street and Seven Sisters. Use Greater Anglia services between Liverpool Street and Cheshunt (via Tottenham Hale).

Rail replacement buses will run:

- Service L1: Seven Sisters – Bruce Grove – White Hart Lane – Silver Street – Edmonton Green – Bush Hill Park – Enfield Town
- Service L2: Seven Sisters – Bruce Grove – White Hart Lane – Silver Street – Edmonton Green – Bush Hill Park – Southbury – Turkey Street – Theobalds Grove – Cheshunt

Sunday: no service between Liverpool Street and Walthamstow Central for Network Rail infrastructure work. Use Tube services instead.

Rail replacement buses will run:

- Service L3: Hackney Downs – Clapton – St James Street – Walthamstow Central

Monday to Thursday: no service between Hackney Downs and Chingford from 10.30pm each night for Network Rail track work.

Use Enfield Town/Cheshunt trains between Liverpool Street and Hackney Downs, or London Underground services.

Rail replacement buses will run:

- Liverpool Street – Bethnal Green – Cambridge Heath – London Fields – Hackney Downs – Clapton – St. James Street – Walthamstow Central – Wood Street – Highams Park – Chingford

Romford to Upminster route

All weekend: no service between Romford and Upminster for Crossrail construction work and Network Rail infrastructure work. Use local bus route 370 instead.

The way to Westfield



VISITORS to the newly expanded Westfield London shopping centre at Shepherd's Bush are advised there will be no services through Wood Lane this weekend.

This is owing to planned improvement work on the Circle and Hammersmith & City lines.

To travel to the launch of the new stores, take the Central line to White City station, which is about a five-minute walk away. Alternatively, bus routes 72 and 220 operate between Hammersmith and Wood Lane.

Westfield London can also be reached as usual via Shepherd's Bush, on both the Central line and London Overground.

Escalator work at North Greenwich

FROM Monday, there will be a reduced service on the up escalators at North Greenwich station.

Planned improvement works mean there will only be one up escalator in service between the westbound platforms and the ticket hall level, until late July. The escalators from the eastbound platforms will not be affected.

Customers are advised to allow extra time to exit the station, particularly during busy periods and events at The O2 Arena.
