

Will your journey be affected this weekend?

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Circle, Jubilee, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines or Docklands Light Railway. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Central line

Part closure

Friday to Monday: trains will not stop at Mile End owing to adjacent District and Hammersmith & City line track work.

District line

Part closure

Friday to Monday: no service between Aldgate East and Dagenham East owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel and track and points replacement work between Bow Road and Barking. Replacement buses will run:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for other TfL services) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking.

Service B: Bethnal Green – Stepney Green (eastbound only) – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for DLR and Jubilee line) – Plaistow – Stratford (for other TfL services).

Service C: Barking – Upney – Becontree – Dagenham Heathway – Dagenham East.

Service D: Barking – Dagenham East.

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

Friday to Monday: no service between Liverpool Street and Barking owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel and track and points replacement between Bow Road and Barking. For replacement buses, see Service A and B above.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

Friday to Monday: no service between Moor Park and Amersham/Chesham owing to bridge replacement work at Rickmansworth. Replacement buses will run between Northwood – Rickmansworth – Chorleywood – Chalfont and Latimer – Amersham – Chesham. For stations north of Rickmansworth you must change at Northwood as the replacement bus service will not serve Moor Park.

Boat Race travel advice

PEOPLE heading to The Boat Race on Sunday are advised that no trains will be running between Clapham Junction and Barnes while work is carried out to replace Fairfield Street bridge near Wandsworth Town station.

Replacement buses will operate between Clapham Junction and Barnes, calling at Wandsworth Town and Putney.

South West Trains will run between Barnes, Barnes Bridge, Chiswick, Kew Bridge and Mortlake throughout the day, but will travel via alternative routes so may take longer and



require changes.

East Putney and Putney Bridge Tube stations will operate as normal, but may be busier than usual.

The work will affect services throughout the Easter weekend, from Friday to Monday.

TfL Rail

Part closure

Friday and Saturday: no service between Gidea Park and Shenfield owing to Crossrail construction work at Shenfield. Use replacement buses.

Sunday and Monday: no service between Liverpool Street and Shenfield owing to Network Rail overhead line and track work, and Crossrail construction at Shenfield. Replacement buses will run until 8am between Shenfield and Ilford, and all weekend between Stratford and Romford, and Newbury Park (Central line) and Shenfield.

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Camden Road and Stratford owing to bridge replacement work at Highbury Corner. Replacement buses will run.

Friday to Sunday: no service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell owing to Crossrail construction at Whitechapel. Replacement buses will run between Camden Road and Stratford, and Dalston Kingsland and Shadwell.

Friday to Sunday: no service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace owing to Crossrail construction at Whitechapel. Use Southern services and local buses.

Sunday (until noon): no service between Gospel Oak and Barking while the line is prepared for electrification. Replacement buses will run from Gospel Oak to Seven Sisters, and between South Tottenham and Barking.

Sunday and Monday: no service between Romford and Upminster owing to Crossrail construction and Network Rail infrastructure work. Use local buses.

Monday: no service between Highbury & Islington and New Cross/New Cross Gate/Clapham Junction owing to Crossrail construction at Whitechapel and TfL track work. Replacement buses will run between Camden Road and Stratford, Dalston Kingsland and New Cross Gate, Shoreditch High Street and Wapping, and Canada Water and Clapham Junction.

London Trams

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Reeves Corner and East Croydon owing to track renewal work in Croydon town centre. Use local buses as valid tram tickets will be accepted.

Piccadilly line strike information

AT the time of going to print, drivers were set to stage a 24-hour strike on the Piccadilly line, which would mean there are no trains running today.

Customers are advised to allow more time for their journeys and to check for the latest updates as other Underground lines will be busier than normal. Extra buses are in operation.

People travelling between Heathrow airport and central London should use the Heathrow Connect and Heathrow Express services, which run from London Paddington station. Check the operators' website for details on TfL ticket acceptance.
