IMPROVEMENTS UNDER WAY

Step-free access changes at Hendon Central

THERE will be no step-free access to the Northern line at Hendon Central Tube station from August 6 until mid-September while lift maintenance work is carried out.

Access to platforms will be via the stairs only.

For step-free access from street to platform take bus 83 to Golders Green station.

For step-free access from street to train take bus 113 to Edgware station.

For step-free access from street to train and the Jubilee line take local bus 324 to Kingsbury station.

Building a better network

Last Sunday, a TfL Rail closure enabled Network Rail to replace 1016 metres of overhead power cables above the westbound track in the Harold Wood area and carry out improvements to the footbridge at Gidea Park station.

As the network is required for freight, there is limited opportunity for routine overnight maintenance so work is planned carefully to minimise disruption to customers.

Happy birthday cycle hire!

LONDON cycle hire celebrates its fifth birthday this week and has now become an integral part of the public transport network.

More than 40 million journeys have been made on hire bikes since the scheme launched and recently the

record for the highest number of hires in one day was broken with 73,000 hires.

The scheme has expanded over the years and there are now 11,500 bikes and 748 docking stations in the capital. Coverage will be extended into Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park next year.

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Metropolitan, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway or TfL Rail. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Circle line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Baker Street and Hammersmith or between Edgware Road and High Street Kensington owing to track replacement work at Paddington, Latimer Road and Edgware Road. A limited service will run between High Street Kensington and Baker Street (via Victoria), and between High Street Kensington and Barking (via Victoria). Replacement buses will call at: Baker Street – Edgware Road – Paddington – Royal Oak – Westbourne Park – Ladbrooke Grove – Latimer Road – Shepherd's Bush (for the Central line, London Overground and National Rail) – Shepherd's Bush Green (for Shepherd's Bush Market and Goldhawk Road) – Hammersmith.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Edgware Road and High Street Kensington or between Earl's Court and Kensington (Olympia) owing to track replacement and station improvements at Edgware Road. Customers travelling to Kensington (Olympia) should use London Overground services from West Brompton.

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Baker Street and Hammersmith owing to track replacement work at Paddington, Latimer Road and Edgware Road. See Circle line for replacement buses.

Jubilee line

Part closure

Saturday: no service between North Greenwich and Stratford owing to bridge repair work at Stratford. Replacement buses will call at North Greenwich and Canning Town. Take the DLR for Canning Town, West Ham and Stratford.

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel. Between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland, use London Overground or local buses via all reasonable routes. Use Tube services via all reasonable routes (for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only). Replacement buses will run.

All weekend: no service between Surrey Quays and New Cross owing to Crossrail work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: no service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will run.

London Trams

Part closure

All weekend: until October, no service between Wimbledon and Dundonald Road owing to platform construction work that will help increase capacity. Trams start and terminate at Dundonald Road, a ten-minute walk to/from Wimbledon station. Local buses connect Wimbledon with London Trams at: Merton Park – Wimbledon (163 and 164); Morden Road – Wimbledon (93); and Phipps Bridge – Wimbledon (200). Tram tickets will be accepted on these buses.

From 10pm Saturday to 10am Sunday: no service between Reeves Corner and East Croydon owing to town centre improvement work. Trams from Beckenham Junction, Elmers End and New Addington will terminate at East Croydon. Trams from Dundonald Road will terminate at Reeves Corner. Line 4 will not run. Bus 410 links East Croydon and Reeves Corner.
