Emirates Air Line to close next week for maintenance

THE Emirates Air Line will close from Monday until Sunday March 23 for essential maintenance work.

The nearest alternative public transport is North Greenwich Tube station on the south side of the Emirates Air Line, which is served by the Jubilee line, and the Royal Victoria DLR station on the north side of the scheme. Both are a short walk away. Bus services are available from North Greenwich bus station and Royal Victoria. River services also operate from North Greenwich Pier next to the Emirates Greenwich Peninsula terminal.

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Jubilee, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or London Tramlank. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Aldgate East and Bromley-By-Bow owing to Crossrail work. Replacement buses will call at: Tower Hill – Aldgate – Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and DLR).

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Moorgate and Barking owing to Crossrail work. See the District line entry for replacement bus information.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Wembley Park and Northwood/Uxbridge owing to track replacement and drainage improvement work. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow (Trevor Avenue) – South Harrow (for the eastbound Piccadilly line) – Rayners Lane – Eastcote – Ruislip Manor – Ruislip – West Ruislip (for the Central line and National Rail services) – Ickenham – Hillingdon – Uxbridge

Service B: Wembley Park – Preston Road – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground services) – Northwick Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow (Pinner Road) – North Harrow – Pinner – Northwood Hills – Northwood

Northern line

Part closure

Sunday: No service between Camden Town and Edgware until approximately 8.30am southbound, and 9am northbound, while new signalling is tested. Bus route N5 will serve all affected stations, except Brent Cross, until services resume.

Piccadilly line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between South Harrow and Uxbridge owing to track replacement and drainage improvement work. See the Metropolitan line entry for replacement bus information.

Docklands Light Railway

Part closure

Saturday from 11pm and all day Sunday: No service between Stratford and Bow Church owing to Crossrail work. Replacement buses will call at: Stratford – Pudding Mill Lane – Bow Church.

London Overground

Part closure

Saturday: No service between Highbury & Islington and Clapham Junction/New Cross/Crystal Palace/West Croydon owing to work to prepare the line for the new five-car trains. Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland to connect with replacement buses to/from Dalston Junction. Replacement bus services will run:

Service X: Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Aldgate East – Tower Gateway – Bermondsey – Canada Water (for Rotherhithe) – Surrey Quays – Deptford Bridge – New Cross – New Cross Gate

Service W: Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell – Wapping

Service M: Canada Water – Surrey Quays – Queens Road Peckham – Peckham Rye – Denmark Hill – Clapham High Street – Wandsworth Road – Clapham Junction

Tickets will also be accepted on:

- Local buses via all reasonable routes
- DLR services between Deptford Bridge and Shadwell
- Tube services via all reasonable routes – be aware that tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations
- Southern services between New Cross Gate and West Croydon, and between Sydenham and Crystal Palace

Sunday: No service between Highbury & Islington and Clapham Junction/New Cross/New Cross Gate owing to work to prepare the line for the new five-car trains. Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland to connect with replacement buses to/from Dalston Junction. Replacement bus services will run:

Service X: Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Aldgate East – Tower Gateway – Bermondsey – Canada Water (for Rotherhithe) – Surrey Quays – Deptford Bridge – New Cross – New Cross Gate

Service W: Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell – Wapping

Service M: Canada Water – Surrey Quays – Queens Road Peckham – Peckham Rye – Denmark Hill – Clapham High Street – Wandsworth Road – Clapham Junction

Tickets will also be accepted on:

- Local buses via all reasonable routes
- DLR services between Deptford Bridge and Shadwell
- Tube services via all reasonable routes – be aware that tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations

Sunday: No service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace owing to work to prepare the line for the new five-car trains. Tickets will be accepted on Southern services between Norwood Junction and Crystal Palace and on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: No service between Willesden Junction and Camden Road until 11.15am owing to Network Rail track work. Tickets will be accepted on local bus and Tube services via all reasonable routes (for entrance/exit only at Willesden Junction, Kilburn, West Hampstead, Finchley Road, Highbury & Islington and Caledonian Road stations).

Sunday: No service between Shepherd's Bush and Willesden Junction until 11.15am owing to Network Rail track work. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: No service between Richmond and Willesden Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Use the District line between Richmond and Gunnersbury. Replacement buses will call at: Gunnersbury – South Acton – Acton Central – Willesden Junction.

Sunday: No northbound service from Clapham Junction to Wandsworth Road until 8.15am owing to Network Rail track work. The 7.20am and 7.50am trains from Clapham Junction to Highbury & Islington will run an alternative route, starting from Battersea Park (at 7.22am and 7.52am), calling at Wandsworth Road and then all stations to Highbury & Islington. Tickets will be accepted on local buses between Clapham Junction and Battersea Park/Surrey Quays via all reasonable routes, and on Southern services between Battersea Park and Clapham Junction. Southbound London Overground services will not be affected.
