weeks to go until the Piccadilly line joins the Night Tube network

There are no planned works on any Tube lines or the DLR. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

London Overground

Part closure

Richmond/Clapham Junction to Stratford route

Saturday: no service between Shepherd's Bush and Willesden Junction owing to Network Rail infrastructure work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: no service between Clapham Junction and Willesden Junction owing to Network Rail infrastructure and track work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Gospel Oak to Barking route

Until February: no service between Gospel Oak and Barking owing to Network Rail work to enable new, longer trains to run from 2018. Replacement buses will run:

Service J: Gospel Oak (bus stops in Highgate Road) – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill (bus stops in Hornsey Road) – Finsbury Park (Tube) – Harringay Green Lanes – Seven Sisters (for South Tottenham).

Service T: Walthamstow Central – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road (bus stops at Harrow Green) – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – East Ham (Tube) – Barking.

At East Ham, eastbound buses will set down only and westbound buses will pick up only. Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road. Use Tube services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central, and between East Ham and Barking.

TfL Rail

Part closure

Saturday: no service between Brentwood and Shenfield. This is while Network Rail carries out track and station improvements, as well as Crossrail construction work.

Greater Anglia trains will call at Brentwood every 20 minutes.

London Trams

Part closure

Sunday: no service between East Croydon and Beckenham Junction/Elmers End/New Addington until 9.30am owing to maintenance of the power supply system. Trams from Wimbledon will terminate at East Croydon. Trams will not run until after 9.30am from New Addington. Lines 1 and 2 will not run until after 9.30am from Elmers End and Beckenham. Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Travelling to Olympia this weekend?

ALL those heading to the Christmas Ideal Home Show at Olympia London this weekend should be aware that travel advice varies depending on which day you go.

On Saturday, passengers should use Kensington (Olympia) station, which can be reached on the London Overground. However, engineering work on Sunday means that London Overground trains will not stop at Kensington (Olympia). The District line will run every 15-20 minutes between Earl's Court and Kensington (Olympia) all weekend.



No more Tube closures before Christmas

PLANNED Tube closures for improvement works are now on hold until after Christmas.

Geoff Hobbs, head of TfL's transport planning, said: 'Weekends in the run-up to Christmas are among our busiest. London Underground recognises that our customers are keen to enjoy all that the capital has to offer in terms of shopping, entertainment and other festivities.'

'As a result, our teams work hard to ensure minimum impact and will cease weekend closures in central London from this weekend until after Christmas.'

Reduced escalator service at North Greenwich

THERE will be a reduced escalator service to/from the westbound platforms at North Greenwich station from Wednesday November 30 until April next year. This is for maintenance work as part of the modernisation of the Tube network. Customers can use other escalators, the staircase or lift to access/exit the platforms.
