of a Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Underground Electric Railways Company of London, Limited - held at Hamilton House, Victoria Embankment, London, E.C. on Tuesday, October 28th 1902.

118 The Works Committee reported that subject to the confirmation of this Board they had appointed Mr. Harley H. Dalrymple-Hay as Chief Engineer of Tube Construction at a salary at the rate of £800. per annum to Christmas 1902, and a salary at the rate of £1,500. from Christmas 1902 for a period of three years from October 15th 1902.

- 119 The Works Committee reported having accepted a Policy from the Employer's Liability Assurance Corporation for a Benefit Policy under the Workmen's Compensation Act insuring the labourers employed by this Company, the rate being 17s/6d. [17 shillings/6 pence] per £100. It was **Resolved** that the same be and is hereby approved.
- 120 It was **Resolved** that Mr Robert W. Perks shall receive a salary from this Company of £4,500. per annum from July 1st 1902 for generally advising on matters pertaining to this Company and it's [its] allied interests.
