

Plan your weekend travel

Find out about line closures and alternative travel options at tfl.gov.uk

There are no planned works on the Central, District, Jubilee, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria and Waterloo & City lines. There are also no planned works on the DLR or London Trams. However, engineering and improvement works will affect the following services:

Bakerloo line

Part closure

Sunday: no service between Queen's Park and Harrow & Wealdstone. There is also no London Overground service between Euston and Watford Junction. Replacement buses will operate:

- Service A: Queen's Park – Kensal Green – Willesden Junction – North Acton (for Central line) – Harlesden – Stonebridge Park – Wembley Central – North Wembley – Preston Road (Metropolitan line, for South Kenton) – Kenton – Harrow & Wealdstone
- Service B: Queen's Park – Kensal Green – Willesden Junction – North Acton (for Central line) – Harlesden – Stonebridge Park – Wembley Central – Harrow & Wealdstone

Circle line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Hammersmith and Tower Hill (via King's Cross St Pancras). Use other Tube routes instead.

A special Circle line service will operate between Edgware Road and Barking (via Victoria).

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between King's Cross St Pancras and Barking. Use other Tube routes instead.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between King's Cross St Pancras and Aldgate. Use other Tube routes and local buses instead.

London Overground

Part closure

Richmond and Clapham Junction to Stratford route

Sunday: no eastbound service between Willesden Junction and Gospel Oak until 9.10am, owing to Network Rail infrastructure work.

Watford Junction to Euston route

Sunday: no service between Euston and Watford Junction owing to Network Rail infrastructure work. There will also be no Bakerloo line service between Queen's Park and Harrow & Wealdstone. Use London Northwestern Railway services between Watford Junction and Euston.

Replacement buses operate:

- Service A: Harrow & Wealdstone – Kenton – Preston Road (Metropolitan line, for South Kenton) – North Wembley – Wembley Central – Stonebridge Park – Harlesden – North Acton (for Central line) – Willesden Junction – Kensal Green – Queen's Park
- Service B: Harrow & Wealdstone – Wembley Central – Stonebridge Park – Harlesden – North Acton (for Central line) – Willesden Junction – Kensal Green – Queen's Park
- Service H: Watford Junction – Watford High Street – Bushey – Carpenders Park – Hatch End – Headstone Lane – Harrow & Wealdstone

London Overground (continued)

Part closure

Highbury & Islington to New Cross/Clapham Junction/ Crystal Palace/West Croydon route

All weekend: no service between New Cross Gate and Crystal Palace/West Croydon, owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses operate:

- New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Park – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (walk for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon

Sunday: no service until 10.30am between Wandsworth Road and Clapham Junction, owing to Network Rail track work. Trains are diverted to/from Battersea Park for Southern connections to/from Clapham Junction.

Liverpool Street to Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters)/ Chingford route

All weekend: no service between Hackney Downs and Chingford owing to Network Rail track work. Use London Underground connections between Liverpool Street, Seven Sisters, Tottenham Hale and Walthamstow Central. Replacement buses will operate:

- Hackney Downs – Clapton – St James Street – Walthamstow Central – Wood Street – Highams Park – Chingford

Romford to Upminster route

All weekend: no service between Romford and Upminster, owing to Crossrail construction work and Network Rail infrastructure work. Use local bus route 370.

TfL Rail

Full closure

All weekend: no service between Liverpool Street and Shenfield. Use the Central line for travel between Liverpool Street and Newbury Park. Replacement buses will run:

- Service A: Stratford City – Forest Gate (Romford Road) – Manor Park (Romford Road) – Ilford – Seven Kings – Goodmayes – Chadwell Heath (Wangey Road) – Romford
- Service B: Newbury Park – Chadwell Heath (Wangey Road) – Romford – Gidea Park – Harold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield

Escalator works at Old Street



THERE will be a temporary one-way system in place at Old Street Tube station from Tuesday, while TfL carries out improvement work on two escalators.

The works will continue until mid-July, with repairs carried out on one escalator at a time to minimise disruption.

During the morning peak (8am to 10.30am), the escalators in service will provide exit only. Entry to the platforms will be via the spiral staircase, which has 100 steps. Customers who are unable to use the stairs should take exit 4

and use buses 43, 205 or 214 from stop E on City Road to Angel station.

At all other times, including the evening peak, there will be one up and one down escalator to and from the platforms.

Please allow extra time for your journey, especially at peak times.
