Tube stations will become collection points for outdoor clothing as the temperature starts to drop.

GENEROUS Londoners are being asked to donate their old and unwanted coats to help keep homeless people warm this winter.

Next week, Wrap up London volunteers will be collecting clothing at five Underground stations before passing it on to more than 100 homeless shelters and charities.

Collection stands will be placed at Canary Wharf, King's Cross, London Bridge, Victoria and Waterloo.

They will be open from 7am to 11am, from Monday November 13 to Wednesday November 15.

Wembley Stadium Friday, 4pm to midnight

Heavy traffic and large crowds expected in the area for the England v Germany football international. Kick-off is at 8pm.

Central London Saturday, 7am to 7pm

Extensive road closures throughout London at various times of the day for the Lord Mayor's Show parade and fireworks. They will affect an area from Bishopsgate in the east, to Old Street in the north, Aldwych in the west and Victoria Embankment in the south. Blackfriars Bridge and Waterloo Bridge will also be closed.

Trafalgar Square Saturday, 8am to Sunday, 6am

Various closures around the square including Pall Mall East and part of Charing Cross Road for a concert.

Twickenham Rugby Stadium Saturday, 11.30am to 6.30pm

Heavy traffic and large crowds expected in the area for the England v Argentina rugby match. Kick-off is at 3pm.

Whitehall Sunday, 12am to 5.30pm

Various road closures will be in place around Whitehall for the preparations and ceremonial parade to mark Remembrance Sunday. Similar events with road closures are being held in Victoria, Tower Hill, Shepherd's Bush Green and the City of London between 10am and midday.
