

Will your journey be affected this weekend?

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Jubilee, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway or TfL Rail. However, the following lines and stations will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Circle line

Full closure

All weekend: No service owing to station improvement work at Moorgate, Barbican and Liverpool Street and track replacement work at Aldgate. Use alternative Tube lines and/or local buses.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Tower Hill and Barking owing to track and drainage work at Aldgate East and Plaistow, and Crossrail work at Whitechapel. Replacement buses will run:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for other TfL services) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking

Service B: Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for DLR and Jubilee line) – Plaistow – Stratford (for other TfL services)

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between King's Cross St. Pancras and Barking owing to track and drainage replacement work at Aldgate East and Plaistow, and Crossrail work at Whitechapel.

Replacement buses will run. See District line for details.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between King's Cross St. Pancras and Aldgate owing to station improvement work at Moorgate, Barbican and Liverpool Street, and track replacement work at Aldgate. Use alternative Tube lines and/or local buses.

Piccadilly line

Station closure

All weekend: Caledonian Road will be closed and trains will not stop owing to lift refurbishment work. Use Holloway Road station or local buses to and from King's Cross St. Pancras.

London Trams

Part closure

Sunday: no service until 10am between New Addington and Lloyd Park owing to maintenance work in the Addington area. Replacement buses will run between New Addington and East Croydon (Dingwall Road).

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell owing to Crossrail construction work. Replacement buses will run between Dalston Kingsland and Shadwell.

All weekend: no service between Gospel Oak and Barking for Network Rail to carry out major works to enable new, longer trains to run from 2018. Replacement buses will run between Gospel Oak and Seven Sisters (for South Tottenham), and between Walthamstow Central and Barking.

Passengers should also be aware that the line will be closed between South Tottenham and Barking on weekdays.

Saturday: no service between Surrey Quays and New Cross owing to Crossrail construction work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: no service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction owing to Crossrail construction work. Replacement buses will run between Canada Water and Clapham Junction.

Ticket hall closure at Liverpool Street

THE ticket hall at Liverpool Street Tube station that leads to and from Old Broad Street will be closed from tomorrow until late August for improvement works.

This closure will allow the majority of the work in the ticket hall to be carried out, while the remainder of the project work throughout the station will continue into 2017.

Once complete, the improvements will include new floor, wall, and ceiling finishes, improved lighting and CCTV, refurbished staircases with new handrails, and improved signage which will create a generally brighter and fresher feel.



Gallop down to the Epsom Derby this weekend

THE Investec Derby takes place on Saturday and the crowds will be flocking to Epsom to soak up the atmosphere.

Getting to the racecourse has been made easier with dedicated bus services on the route to Epsom from Morden and back. The buses will depart from a temporary bus stop in London Road opposite Morden station.

Route 864 buses will leave every 20-30 minutes between 10am until 6.20pm. Services returning to Morden station will run frequently, with the last bus departing Epsom at 7.45pm.

Route 865 buses (via Sutton) will leave the station at 10.30am, 11.30am, 12.30pm and 1.30pm. The final bus to depart from Epsom will leave at around 7.30pm, or once the crowds have left.

These services are operated by Go-Ahead and no other tickets or passes (including Oyster cards) are valid. Oyster card holders can get a discount.

■ **A full adult ticket costs £7 single and £12 return. Oyster and Travelcard holders, children and concessions can buy a single ticket for £5 and return for £10.**
