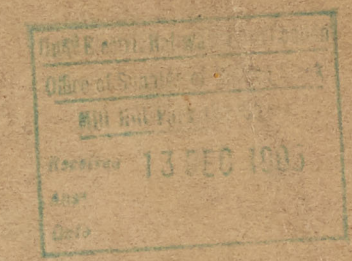

## INSTRUCTIONS.

The General Register must be produced whenever required by any of H.M. Inspectors of Factories and Workshops. An old Register must be kept for at least two years after the date of the last entry.

Any entry made by the Occupier or on his behalf is, as against him, *prima facie* evidence of the facts therein stated; and failure to make any entry with respect to the observance of any provision of the Factory Act, 1901, is admissible as *prima facie* evidence that the provision has not been observed.

## I. General.

The Occupier must enter in Part I. all the particulars required therein.

II. Young Persons.  
III. Children.

The Occupier must enter in Columns 1 to 6 of Parts II. and III. particulars of all Young Persons and Children employed†, and in the case of a Factory the Certificate of Fitness (Columns 7 to 11) must be obtained from the Certifying Surgeon, as follows:—

## Certificates of Fitness.

A Child, or Young Person under Sixteen, must not be employed in a Factory for more than *seven* (or if the Certifying Surgeon resides more than three miles from the Factory, *thirteen*) Work Days without a Certificate of Fitness for employment in that Factory. This Certificate can only be given by the Certifying Surgeon for the District, and by means of signed entry in the General Register.\* He cannot grant it except after personal examination; nor elsewhere than at the Factory, unless fewer than five Young Persons and Children are employed there. The Certificate may be qualified by conditions as to the work on which the Child or Young Person is fit to be employed. When a Child becomes a Young Person a fresh Certificate of Fitness, for Full Time Employment, must be obtained.

Educational Certificates—  
for Children;  
for Young Persons under 14.

A Child under Twelve cannot be employed. A Child above Twelve may be employed for half-time if he has obtained a "Labour Certificate" from the Local School Authority qualifying for half-time employment. This Certificate must be kept by the Occupier, and the date entered in Column 6 of Part III.

A Child who has reached the age of Thirteen, and has obtained a Certificate from the Local School Authority qualifying for Full Time Employment†, is regarded as a Young Person. The Certificate must be kept by the Occupier, and the date entered in Column 6 of Part II.

## IV. Accidents.

The Occupier must enter in Part IV. the particulars of every Accident of which notice is required to be sent to the Inspector (that is, any Accident which causes to a person employed either loss of life or such bodily injury as to prevent him, on one of the three working days next after the occurrence of the Accident, from being employed for five hours on his ordinary work).

## V. Industrial Poisoning.

The Occupier must enter in Part V. the particulars of every case of Anthrax or of Poisoning by Lead, Phosphorus, Arsenic, or Mercury.

## VI. Limewashing.

The Occupier must enter in Part VI. particulars as to the Limewashing, Painting with Oil, Varnishing, or Washing with hot water and soap, required by the Act (see Abstract). If in any part of the premises exemption from this requirement is claimed under a Special Exception, entry to that effect must be made in Part VI.

## VII. Employment in Shop.

If the Occupier of a Factory or Workshop at any time employs a Woman or Young Person on the same day both therein, and also in a Shop before or after the Period of Employment fixed by Notice, the required entries must be made in Part VII.

## VIII. Steam Boilers.

The Occupier must cause a thorough examination of every Steam Boiler to be made every 14 months; and a signed Report of the examination, in the form shown in Part VIII., to be entered in or attached to this Register within 14 days.

Overtime Register (Form 338).  
List of Outworkers (Form 44).

These are special Registers. The former must be kept in every Factory, Workshop and Laundry where overtime is worked under a special exception. The latter must be kept in every Factory, Workshop and Laundry in the business of which outworkers are employed in any of the classes of work specified in the Abstract, and in every place from which such work is given out.

\* The Certificate may, if the Certifying Surgeon thinks fit, name all the Factories within his district which are in the occupation of the same Occupier. In this case a separate Form of Certificate is to be signed by the Certifying Surgeon and kept by the Occupier, who must then write across Column 10 of the Register the number and date of the Certificate and the name of the Certifying Surgeon.

† In districts where the Education Bye-laws apply to Children between Thirteen and Fourteen, a child of that age cannot be employed Full Time unless he has satisfied the conditions prescribed by the Bye-laws for total exemption.

‡ Employment is thus defined by the Act:—"A woman, young person, or child who works in a factory or workshop, whether for wages or not, either in a manufacturing process or handicraft, or in cleaning any part of the factory or workshop used for any manufacturing process or handicraft, or in cleaning or oiling any part of the machinery, or in any other kind of work whatsoever incidental to or connected with the manufacturing process or handicraft, or connected with the article made or otherwise the subject of the manufacturing process or handicraft therein, shall, save as is otherwise provided by this Act, be deemed to be employed therein within the meaning of this Act. For the purposes of this Act an apprentice shall be deemed to work for hire."

## Correction Form for General Register.

The General Register must be in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, and those of earlier date than 1907 are no longer in the form now prescribed. Where, however, a General Register has been in use up to April 1st, 1907, it may temporarily be retained in use provided (i) that this Form is inserted in it, (ii) that the instructions herein contained are fully observed, and (iii) that in workshops in which certificates of fitness are required the smaller edition (Form 38) of the General Register shall not be retained in use, as regards Parts II. and III.\*

Part I. (General). The total number of persons employed, as well as the date on which the last statutory return was made, should be stated in the space formerly provided for the date only.

Part II. (Young Persons). } In workshops in which certificates of fitness are required, "workshop" must be substituted for  
Part III. (Children). } "factory" in column 10.

Part IV. (Accidents). In the blank column at the end, entry must be made of the dates on which the injured person was prevented by the accident from being employed at all on his ordinary work.

Part VIII. (Steam Boilers). The form of report of inspection (Form 55) has been revised. Reports in the revised Form must be attached, within the appointed times, to the guard slips provided for the purpose.

At the end of the Register should be attached (in addition to the reports of inspection of steam boilers) all statutory certificates relating to the premises, whether (a) from the Local Authority, as to means of escape from fire, or (b) from the Chief Inspector, as to part of the premises being treated as a separate factory or workshop, or (c) from the District Inspector, as to separation of departments.

### FEES OF CERTIFYING SURGEONS.

The fees of the Certifying Surgeon for the examination of children and young persons, and grant of Certificates of fitness for employment, are to be paid by the Occupier.

The Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, Section 124, enacts as follows:—

(1.) The fees to be paid to a Certifying Surgeon in respect of the examination of, and grant of certificates of fitness for employment for, young persons and children shall be regulated as follows:—

(a) The occupier of the factory may agree with the Certifying Surgeon as to the amount of the fees;

(b) In the absence of agreement the fees shall be in accordance with the scale set forth in Part I. of the Fifth Schedule to this Act, or with such scale as may be substituted therefor by the Secretary of State;

(c) The occupier shall pay the fees on the completion of the examination, or if any certificates are granted, at the time at which the Surgeon signs the certificates, or at any other time directed by an Inspector.

#### FIFTH SCHEDULE.

##### PART I.

Fees on examination for certificates of fitness for employment.

When the examination is at the factory or workshop.

2s. 6d. for each visit, and 6d. for each person after the first five examined at that visit; and also if the factory or workshop is more than one mile from the Surgeon's residence, 6d. for each complete half mile over and above the mile.

When the examination is not at the factory or workshop, but at the residence of the Surgeon, or at some place appointed by the Surgeon for the purpose, and that place as well as the day and hour appointed for the purpose has been published in the prescribed manner.
