Beat the heat this summer

To help stay comfortable while travelling during this spell of hot weather, you are advised to:

- Carry a bottle of water
- Not board a train or bus if feeling unwell
- Get off at the next stop and seek help from staff, if feeling unwell
- Avoid pulling the passenger alarm between stations when travelling on a train or Tube. Instead, get off of the train at the next stop as help can be more easily obtained on a platform

There are no planned track works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway or London Tramlink. However, the following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement work.

Bakerloo line

Station closure

Edgware Road: Closed until late December owing to lift replacement work. Edgware Road (Circle and Hammersmith & City lines) is the nearest alternative station. Trains from here connect with Bakerloo line services at Baker Street and Paddington.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Tower Hill and Barking owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel and track replacement at Stepney Green. Replacement bus services will run:
Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for the Central and Jubilee lines, Docklands Light Railway and London Overground) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking

Service B: Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and Docklands Light Railway) – Plaistow – Stratford (for the Central and Jubilee lines, Docklands Light Railway and London Overground)

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Liverpool Street and Barking owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel and track replacement at Stepney Green. See the District line entry for replacement bus services.

Jubilee line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between West Hampstead and Stanmore owing to track replacement work on the adjacent Metropolitan line. Replacement bus services will run:
Service C: Stonebridge Park (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) – Wembley Park – Kingsbury – Queensbury – Canons Park – Stanmore

Service D: Finchley Road – West Hampstead (southbound only) – Kilburn – Willesden Green – Dollis Hill – Neasden – Wembley Park

Customers travelling northbound on the replacement bus service must change at Finchley Road as this service will not stop at West Hampstead.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Aldgate and Northwood/Uxbridge owing to track replacement at Wembley Park and drainage improvement work at Northwick Park. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Rayners Lane (for the Piccadilly line to Uxbridge and central London)

Service B: Wembley Park – Preston Road – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground) – Northwick Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Pinner – Northwood Hills – Northwood

To help customers during the Metropolitan line closure, the Piccadilly line will also run an enhanced service, with trains every 10 minutes between Rayners Lane and Uxbridge.

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: No service between South Tottenham and Barking owing to Network Rail track renewal work. Replacement buses will call at: South Tottenham – Blackhorse Road – Walthamstow Queen's Road – Walthamstow Central – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – Barking.

All weekend: No service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel. Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland to connect with replacement buses to/from Dalston Junction. Valid tickets will also be accepted on local bus routes. Replacement buses will call at: Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell.

Tickets will also be accepted on Tube services via all reasonable routes. Tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford Tube stations.

All weekend: No service between Surrey Quays and New Cross owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel. Tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: Until midday, no service between Gospel Oak and South Tottenham owing to Network Rail bridge replacement work. Tickets will be accepted on the replacement buses which will call at: Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (bus stops in Agincourt Road/Southampton Road) – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill – Harringay Green Lanes – South Tottenham.

Sunday: After 9.30pm, no service between Gospel Oak and Stratford owing to Network Rail track work. Tickets will be accepted on replacement buses which will call at: Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (bus stops in Agincourt Road/Southampton Road) – Kentish Town West (bus stops in Prince of Wales Road) – Camden Road – Holloway Road Tube (for Caledonian Road & Barnsbury) – Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford.

A connecting westbound bus service will also run at 11.35pm and 12.10am (setting down only), calling on request at: Hampstead Heath – Finchley Road Tube (for Finchley Road & Frognal) – West Hampstead – Brondesbury – Brondesbury Park – Kensal Rise – Willesden Junction – Acton Central – South Acton – Gunnersbury – Kew Gardens – Richmond.
