Submitted a Statement of the financial results of the  
working of all companies for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December  
1913, which was discussed and in view of the period which  
will elapse before the confirmation of the dividends by the  
various companies in General Meeting, it was considered



desirable that an announcement should be made to the Press to the effect that the Underground Company would be able to meet the full dividend on the 4½ Income Debenture Stock and 6½ Income Bonds for the half year ended 31st December 1913. The Assistant Secretary was therefore authorised to notify the Secretary of the Stock Exchange and the Press.

### 1743 Date of Annual Meeting

Reported as to suggested date for the Annual Meeting and it was resolved that the Annual Meeting should be held on Thursday March 5th at 11 a.m. at the Westminster Palace Hotel, Victoria Street, Westminster, S.W.

### 1744 Central London Railway Unassented Stock

Reported as to further applications from Central London Railway Shareholders to be allowed to accept the offer of the Underground Company. The same were discussed and

It was resolved that no further applications be entertained.

### 1745 Passes

Submitted specimens of the Free passes in use and explained the system upon which these were issued to the Staff.

### 1746 Sale by London Electric Railway Company of £397,471-4½% Debenture Stock

The Assistant Secretary reported that the London Electric Railway Company had sold £397,471 of 4½% Debenture Stock at 85 net.

### 1747 Alteration to Memorandum and Articles of Association

The Solicitor explained that as the Company is now a Commercial or Trading Company it would be unable to pay dividends unless its Capital is represented by assets of equal value and that there were two courses open to the Company.

1. Either to apply for a reduction of Capital or
2. To convert the Company into a holding Trust Company for which purpose it would be necessary to alter the Memorandum and Articles of Association and to obtain the consent of the Court.

Counsel had advised in conference that the second alternative could be carried out.

It was resolved that the necessary steps be taken to convert the Company into a holding Trust Company and that the Chairman and Managing Director be requested to settle in conjunction with the Solicitor, the necessary



alterations in the Memorandum and Articles of Association, and to draw up an explanatory circular to the Shareholders.
