

Plan your weekend travel

Find out about line closures and alternative travel options at tfl.gov.uk

With the exception of the Central line, there are no planned works on any other Tube lines this weekend or on TfL Rail. Engineering and improvement works will affect the following services:

Central line

Part closure

All weekend (from 2.50am Saturday): no service between Bethnal Green and Loughton/Woodford via the Hainault loop owing to track replacement work at Leytonstone. Replacement buses will run.

* Stratford City – Leyton – Leytonstone – Snaresbrook – Wanstead – Redbridge

(This route does not run overnight on Friday or Saturday – use bus route N8 between Stratford and Hainault).

* Stratford City – Snaresbrook – South Woodford – Woodford – Roding Valley – Buckhurst Hill – Loughton

* Ilford (for TfL Rail) – Gants Hill – Newbury Park – Barkingside – Fullwell Cross – Fairlop – Hainault – Grange Hill – Chigwell – Roding Valley – Woodford

(This route does not run overnight on Friday or Saturday – use bus route N8 between Stratford and Hainault).

London Overground

Part closure

Gospel Oak to Barking route

All weekend: no service between Gospel Oak and Barking while Network Rail carries out major works to enable new, longer trains to run from 2018. Replacement buses will run.

* Gospel Oak – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill – Finsbury Park (for the Victoria and Piccadilly lines) – Harringay Green Lanes – Seven Sisters (for the Victoria line and South Tottenham)

* Walthamstow Central (for the Victoria line) – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – East Ham (for the District and Hammersmith & City lines) – Barking

At East Ham, eastbound buses will set down only and westbound buses will pick up only.

On Sunday, from 10.30am to 12.30pm, replacement buses will not run between East Ham and Barking owing to local road closures. Use the Tube instead.

Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road, or Tube services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central, and between East Ham and Barking.

Highbury & Islington to New Cross/Clapham Junction/Crystal Palace/West Croydon route

All weekend: no service between New Cross Gate and Crystal Palace/West Croydon owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will run between New Cross Gate and West Croydon.

Sunday: no service between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Junction owing to crane operations. Use alternative London Overground trains or local buses.

Docklands Light Railway

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Bank and Tower Gateway to Poplar and West India Quay owing to track work. Replacement buses will run between Tower Gateway and Westferry.

Sunday: no service between Stratford and Bow Church owing to Crossrail works at Pudding Mill Lane. Use local buses.

London Trams

Part closure

All weekend: no service between New Addington and Lloyd Park owing to track renewal work. Replacement buses will run between New Addington and East Croydon.

Central line car park closures

PARKING at three Central line stations will be suspended this weekend while major engineering works take place between Bethnal Green and Loughton/Woodford (via Hainault).

The car parks are at South Woodford and Leytonstone, which will close from 8pm on Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday, and Snaresbrook, which will close from Friday until Monday morning.

Replacement bus services will run. See the separate Central line entry on this page for details.

Lift work at Goodge Street

CUSTOMERS using Goodge Street station will have a limited lift service from Monday when refurbishment work begins.

Improvements are being made on all four lifts, two at a time, and should be completed by late 2018.

The station will be exit-only on weekday mornings between 7.30am and 10am.

Northern line passengers starting their journeys are advised to use nearby Tottenham Court Road or Warren Street stations, which are a six-minute walk away.

Better service at Holborn

A MAJOR milestone was reached at Holborn station this week when the third escalator serving the Piccadilly line platforms was returned to service.

The completion of the work means Central line passengers can now switch trains again on to the Piccadilly line during the morning peak, something they were unable to do while the escalators were being refurbished.

Work is continuing on the upper escalators that lead to the ticket hall, so the station will remain exit-only between 7.30am and 10am on weekdays until next spring.
