WHITEHALL and Parliament Street will be closed from 6am, and more streets in the area will be closed from 8am, as London marks Remembrance Sunday. Streets will reopen in the afternoon following the conclusion of the Service at the Cenotaph.

Roads closures in central London and the City

THE Lord Mayor's Show and Regent Street Christmas lights switch-on take place this weekend. The events will be held on closed roads, some of which will be shut from 7am. To avoid delays, you are advised to plan ahead. However, some buses will be on diversion or will finish early owing to the road and bridge closures, and stations around central London and the City will be busy.

Weekend closures on the Stansted Express

OWING to Network Rail engineering work, the Stansted Express rail service will not run for the next three weekends. A direct bus service will operate between Liverpool Street and Stansted. This work will also affect customers heading to the Spurs vs Newcastle game on Sunday, as trains will not serve Northumberland Park station. Use White Hart Lane or Seven Sisters stations instead of travelling to the match.

There are no planned track works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee, Metropolitan, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or London Tramlink. The following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works:

Bakerloo line

Station closure

Edgware Road: Closed until late December owing to lift replacement work. Edgware Road (Circle and Hammersmith & City lines) is the nearest alternative station. Trains from here connect with Bakerloo line services at Baker Street and Paddington.

District line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Turnham Green and Ealing Broadway while track and points are replaced in the Acton Town area. Replacement bus service A will call at: Turnham Green – Chiswick Park – Acton Town – Ealing Common – Ealing Broadway – South Ealing – Northfields – Boston Manor – Osterley.

Northern line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Kennington and Morden while new signalling is tested. Replacement bus services will run:

Service H: Clapham Common – Clapham South – Balham (for National Rail services to/from Victoria) – Tooting Bec – Tooting Broadway – Colliers Wood – South Wimbledon – Morden

Service J: Elephant & Castle – Kennington – Oval – Stockwell – Clapham North – Clapham Common – Clapham South – Balham (for National Rail services to/from Victoria). Southbound buses will call at Tooting Bec

Service X: Wimbledon (for District line and National Rail services to/from Waterloo on Saturday only) – South Wimbledon – Morden

Piccadilly line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Hammersmith and Ealing Common/Osterley while track and points are replaced in the Acton Town area. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: Turnham Green – Chiswick Park – Acton Town – Ealing Common – Ealing Broadway – South Ealing – Northfields – Boston Manor – Osterley

Service B (westbound, non-stop): Gunnersbury (for District line to/from central London) – Heathrow Terminals 1,2,3

Service B (eastbound, non-stop): Heathrow Terminals 1,2,3 – Osterley – Gunnersbury (for District line to/from central London)

Service C (westbound): Gunnersbury (for District line to/from central London) – Heathrow Terminal 5 – Heathrow Terminal 4

Service C (eastbound): Heathrow Terminal 4 – Heathrow Terminal 5 – Hammersmith

London Overground

Part closure

Saturday: No service between Kilburn High Road and Euston from 7.15pm owing to Network Rail track work. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on local bus and Tube services via all reasonable routes – be aware that these tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Queen's Park, Kilburn Park, Euston Square and Euston.

Saturday: No service between South Tottenham and Barking until midday owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will call at: South Tottenham – Blackhorse Road – Walthamstow Queen's Road – Walthamstow Central – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – Barking.

First through trains: Gospel Oak to Barking at 11.55am; Barking to Gospel Oak at 12.08am

Sunday: No service between Gospel Oak and Stratford from 9.30pm owing to Network Rail track work. A replacement bus service will run between Hampstead Heath and Stratford.

Sunday: No service between Highbury & Islington and New Cross Gate until 8.15am owing to track improvement work.

Sunday: No service between Surrey Quays and Wandsworth Road until 8.15am owing to track improvement work.

Sunday: No service between Wandsworth Road and Clapham Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Trains to/from Clapham Junction are diverted to start/terminate at Battersea Park. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on Southern services between Battersea Park and Clapham Junction and on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: No service between Kilburn High Road and Euston until 12.15pm and after 8.15pm owing to Network Rail track work.

All weekend: No service between New Cross Gate and Crystal Palace/West Croydon owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will call at: New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Park – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon.

Docklands Light Railway

Part closure

Sunday: No service between Stratford and Bow Church owing to Crossrail work at Pudding Mill Lane station. Replacement buses will call at: Stratford – Pudding Mill Lane – Bow Church.
