## Preparing Farringdon station for Crossrail

CLOSURES this weekend on the Circle, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan lines will enable work to enlarge and rebuild Farringdon station to continue, ahead of Crossrail opening.

When Crossrail is complete in 2018, Farringdon will become one of Britain's busiest train stations. It will also provide a key link from outer London to the business hubs in the City and Canary Wharf.

When the station becomes an interchange for London Underground, Thameslink and Crossrail services, more than 140 trains an hour will pass through. It will be the only station where passengers will be able to access all

three networks, direct connection for three London airports, plus St. Pancras International for Eurostar services.

#### Progress so far

As part of preparations at the station, London Underground has already built two new ticket halls, restored the original entrance, and installed 36 ticket gates, 26 help points, 126 CCTV cameras, 20 staircases, five step-free access lifts and a footbridge.

When work is complete, passengers will be able to travel north, south, east or west. There will also be step-free access to all platforms.

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, District, Jubilee, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or Docklands Light Railway. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement work.

#### Circle line

#### Part closure

**Saturday:** No service between Moorgate and King's Cross St. Pancras owing to work at Farringdon station. Use alternative Tube lines and/or local buses.

**Farringdon:** Closed on Sunday. Use nearby Barbican or King's Cross St. Pancras.

#### Hammersmith & City line

#### Part closure

**Saturday:** No service between King's Cross St. Pancras and Barking owing to work at Farringdon station. Use alternative Tube lines and/or local buses.

**Farringdon:** See Circle line entry.

#### Metropolitan line

#### Part closure

**Saturday:** No service between Baker Street and Aldgate owing to work at Farringdon station. Use alternative Tube lines and/or local buses.

**All weekend:** No service between Harrow-on-the-Hill and Uxbridge owing to track replacement work in the Hillingdon area. Replacement buses will call at: Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Rayners Lane – Eastcote – Ruislip Manor – Ruislip – West Ruislip (for the Central line) – Ickenham – Hillingdon – Uxbridge.

**Sunday:** No service between Harrow-on-the-Hill and Uxbridge owing to track replacement in the Hillingdon area until 9pm when the closure will extend from Wembley Park to Northwood/Uxbridge. Replacement buses will run (see above). After 9pm, an additional service will run as follows: Wembley Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill – North Harrow – Pinner – Northwood Hills – Northwood.

**Farringdon:** See Circle line entry.

#### Northern line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Archway and High Barnet/Mill Hill East owing to the installation of new signalling. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: All stations between Archway and High Barnet

Service C: Finchley Central – Mill Hill East

#### Piccadilly line

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Acton Town and Uxbridge owing to track replacement work in the Hillingdon and Sudbury areas. Replacement buses will call at: Acton Town – Ealing Common – North Ealing – Hanger Lane (for Park Royal and the Central line), then all stations to Rayners Lane (for the Metropolitan line replacement buses to Uxbridge).

#### London Overground

#### Part closure

**Sunday:** No service between Kilburn High Road and Euston owing to Network Rail track work. Valid tickets will be accepted on local buses and Tube services for entrance/exit at Queen's Park, Kilburn Park, Euston Square and Euston stations.

**Sunday:** No service between Willesden Junction and Camden Road until 12.30pm owing to Network Rail track maintenance work. Replacement buses will call at: Willesden Junction – Kensal Rise – Brondesbury Park – Brondesbury – West Hampstead – Finchley Road Tube (for Finchley Road & Frognal) – Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (bus stops at station) – Kentish Town West (bus stops in Kentish Town Road) – Camden Road. Tickets will be accepted on local buses and Tube services via all reasonable routes.

**Sunday:** No northbound service between Clapham Junction and Wandsworth Road until 8.15am owing to Network Rail track maintenance work. The 7.20am and 7.50am to Highbury & Islington will start from Battersea Park. Tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes between Clapham Junction and Wandsworth Road, and on Southern rail services between Clapham Junction and Battersea Park, via Victoria.

**Sunday:** No service between Gospel Oak and South Tottenham until 11am owing to engineering work. Replacement buses will call at: Gospel Oak (Agincourt Road/Southampton Road bus stops) – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill – Harringay Green Lanes – South Tottenham.

#### London Tramlink

#### Part closure

**All weekend:** No service between Arena and Beckenham Junction owing to Network Rail and Tramlink track improvement work. Replacement buses will call at Elmers End, Birkbeck, Beckenham Road and Beckenham Junction stops. The buses will not serve Harrington Road or Avenue Road tram stops. Line 4 will not run on Saturday. Tickets will be accepted on local buses.
