

# Plan your weekend travel

With the exception of the Northern line, there are no planned works on any other Tube lines or on London Trams. However, the following services will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

## Northern line

## Part closure

**All weekend:** no service between Archway and High Barnet/Mill Hill East from about 1:25am on Saturday and all day Sunday owing to track improvement works at Highgate and High Barnet. Replacement buses will run.

Archway – Highgate – East Finchley – Finchley Central – West Finchley – Woodside Park – Totteridge & Whetstone – High Barnet

## London Overground

## Part closure

### Romford to Upminster route

**All weekend:** no service between Romford and Upminster owing to Network Rail track work and Crossrail construction work. Use local buses.

### Richmond/Clapham Junction to Stratford route

**Sunday:** no service between Camden Road and Stratford owing to bridge replacement works at Highbury Corner and Network Rail station work at Hackney Wick. Replacement buses will run.

### Highbury & Islington to New Cross/Clapham Junction/ Crystal Palace/West Croydon route

**Sunday:** no service between Wandsworth Road and Clapham Junction until 11.45am owing to Network Rail track work. Trains will run along an alternative route to/from Battersea Park. Use local buses or Southern services between Clapham Junction and Battersea Park.

## Docklands Light Rail

## Part closure

**Until December:** trains will not be stopping at Custom House while station work takes place to prepare for the start of Elizabeth line services. Use local buses.

**All weekend:** no service between Bow Church and Stratford owing to Crossrail construction work at Pudding Mill Lane. Use local buses.

## TfL Rail

## Full closure

**All weekend:** no service on the entire line owing to Network Rail track and station improvements and Crossrail construction work. Replacement buses will run.

Stratford – Forest Gate – Manor Park – Ilford – Seven Kings – Goodmayes – Chadwell Heath – Romford  
Newbury Park (for the Central line) – Chadwell Heath (westbound only) – Romford – Gidea Park – Harold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield

Change at Romford for Chadwell Heath if necessary

## Cable car closed

THE Emirates Air Line remains closed this weekend while the planned annual maintenance is completed.

Passengers are advised to use the DLR and

local bus services from Royal Victoria if travelling from the north side of the river, and the Jubilee line, local buses or the river boat from North Greenwich if coming from the south side.

The essential work happens every year to ensure the highest standards of safety are maintained on the cable car.



## Travelling for the craic

LARGE crowds are expected in central London on Sunday as the capital celebrates St Patrick's Day.

Although festivities will centre on Trafalgar Square, the annual parade follows a route from Piccadilly to Whitehall and many roads will be closed.

Affected areas include Piccadilly, Piccadilly Circus, Shaftesbury Avenue, Haymarket, Regent Street, St James's, Waterloo Place, Pall Mall, Cockspur Street, Trafalgar Square and its approaches, Whitehall and Whitehall Place.

Buses in the event area are likely to be busier than usual so passengers are advised to allow plenty of time and plan ahead. The latest bus information can be found on [tfl.gov.uk](https://tfl.gov.uk) and also by following @TfLBUSAlerts on Twitter.

Tube and rail will be the best way to get around on the day, although some stations in the area will be busier than normal. These include Green Park (Jubilee, Piccadilly and Victoria lines), Leicester Square (Northern and Piccadilly lines), Charing Cross (Bakerloo and Northern lines), Piccadilly Circus (Bakerloo and Piccadilly lines) and Embankment (Bakerloo, Circle, District and Northern lines).
