

Traffic diversions around Hammersmith Flyover

THE Hammersmith Flyover will be closed to eastbound traffic (towards London) this weekend for essential roadworks. The eastbound carriageway will also be closed for the next three weekends, followed by the westbound carriageway for five weekends.

Drivers who are able to do so are advised to plan their journeys and use the signed diversion route via the A40 Western Avenue, to avoid driving through Hammersmith.

Last weekend drivers using the signed diversion experienced significantly less delays than those using local roads around Hammersmith. At peak times, journeys took only an extra 25 minutes compared to more than an hour for journeys via Hammersmith itself.

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Hammersmith & City, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway or London Tramlink. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Circle line Part closure

All weekend: No service between Gloucester Road and Edgware Road, via High Street Kensington, owing to track replacement work at Bayswater. Use alternative Tube and/or bus services.

District line Part closure

All weekend: No service between Earl's Court and Edgware Road owing to track replacement work at Bayswater. Use alternative Tube and/or bus services.

Jubilee line Part closure

Sunday (until 11am): No service between Waterloo and Finchley Road due to essential tunnelling work. Use alternative Tube and/or bus services.

Metropolitan line Part closure

All weekend: No service between Moor Park and Amersham/Chesham due to drainage work at Amersham and work on points at Rickmansworth. Also, no Chiltern Railways services between Marylebone and Aylesbury Vale Parkway. Replacement buses will operate between Northwood - Rickmansworth - Chorleywood - Chalfont & Latimer - Amersham - Chesham.

No bus replacement service will operate to/from Moor Park. For stations between Rickmansworth and Amersham/Chesham, change at Northwood for replacement bus services

Northern line Part closure

All weekend: No service between Camden Town and Kennington via Bank owing to track improvement work. Use alternative Tube and/or bus services.

London Overground Part closure

Sunday: No service between Richmond and Camden Road via West Hampstead owing to Network Rail track work and preparations to introduce five-car trains to the line. Replacement buses will call at: Gunnersbury - South Acton - Acton Central - Willesden Junction - Kensal Rise - Brondesbury Park - Brondesbury - West Hampstead - Finchley Road Tube (for Finchley Road & Frognal) - Hampstead Heath - Gospel Oak (bus stops at station) - Kentish Town West (bus stops in Kentish Town Road) - Camden Road. Valid rail tickets will be accepted. Trains will run to an amended timetable along an alternative route between Willesden Junction (low level platforms) and Stratford, calling at Kensal Green, Queen's Park, Kilburn High Road, South Hampstead, Camden Road and all stations to/from Stratford.

Sunday: No service between Shepherd's Bush and Willesden Junction owing to preparations to introduce five-car trains to the line. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday (until 12 noon): No service between South Tottenham and Barking due to Network Rail bridge works. Replacement buses will call at: South Tottenham - Blackhorse Road - Walthamstow Queen's Road - Walthamstow Central - Leyton Midland Road - Leytonstone High Road - Wanstead Park - Woodgrange Park - Barking. Valid rail tickets will be accepted. The first through trains will be Gospel Oak to Barking 11.55am, and Barking to Gospel Oak 12.08pm.

Sunday: No service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction due to Network Rail and Thameslink work. Replacement buses will call at: Canada Water - Surrey Quays - Queens Road Peckham - Peckham Rye - Denmark Hill - Clapham High Street - Wandsworth Road - Clapham Junction. Valid rail tickets will be accepted.
