IMPROVEMENTS UNDER WAY

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, District, Hammersmith & City, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or Docklands Light Railway. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Hammersmith & City line Station closure

All weekend: from tomorrow, Royal Oak station will be closed for improvement work. Ticket issuing facilities will not be available. See right for alternative travel advice.

Jubilee line Part closure

All weekend: no service between Waterloo and Stanmore while tunnel lining is replaced at Bond Street, points work is carried out at Neasden and track replacement takes place at Wembley Park. Replacement bus services will run:

Service C: Stonebridge Park (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground services) – Wembley Park – Kingsbury – Queensbury – Canons Park (Honeypot Lane) – Stanmore
Service D: Baker Street – St John's Wood – Swiss Cottage – Finchley Road – West Hampstead – Kilburn – Willesden Green – Dollis Hill – Neasden – Wembley Park

Metropolitan line Part closure

All weekend: no service between Aldgate and Rickmansworth/Watford to allow for points work at Neasden and track replacement work at Wembley Park and Moor Park. Services will run as follows: Amersham – Rickmansworth every 30 minutes; Chesham – Rickmansworth every 30 minutes; Uxbridge – Harrow-on-the-Hill every 13-17 minutes. Replacement bus services will also run:

Service A: Northwood – Moor Park

Service B: Wembley Park – Preston Road – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line and London Overground services) – Northwick Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill – North Harrow – Pinner – Northwood Hills – Northwood – Rickmansworth

Service E: West Ruislip (for the Central line and Chiltern Railways) – Ruislip (for the Piccadilly line. Only buses heading to Watford Junction stop at Ruislip) – Rickmansworth – Croxley – Watford – Watford Junction (for London Overground and National Rail services).

There will be no Chiltern Railways service between Amersham and Harrow-on-the Hill, however additional trains will run between Marylebone and Harrow-on-the-Hill. A Chiltern Railways replacement bus service will call at: Great Missenden – Amersham – Beaconsfield (for connections to London Marylebone).

London Overground Part closure

Sunday: no service between Camden Road and Stratford owing to work to prepare the network for five-car trains. Replacement buses will run.

Sunday: no service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace until 8.30am owing to Network Rail track work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes or Southern services between Norwood Junction and Crystal Palace. Replacement buses will run between London Bridge and West Croydon.

Sunday: no service between New Cross Gate and West Croydon until 9am owing to Network Rail track work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes or use the replacement buses that will run between London Bridge and West Croydon.

London Trams

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Reeves Corner and East Croydon, or between Elmers End and Arena owing to town centre improvement works and track replacement at Tamworth Road. Trams from Beckenham Junction, Elmers End and New Addington will terminate at East Croydon. Trams from Wimbledon will terminate at Reeves Corner. Line 4 will not run. Bus 410 links East Croydon and Reeves Corner but owing to extensive roadworks, passengers may find it quicker to walk. A leaflet is available showing the walking route. Valid tram tickets will be accepted on local buses. Oyster pay as you go customers can receive a refund if they touch in correctly when boarding and changing from tram to bus to complete their journey.

Closure of Royal Oak station

FROM tomorrow until mid-May, Royal Oak station will be closed for improvement work.

The existing staircase will be demolished and a new one will be built, making it fit for use for many years to come. As this staircase is the only means of access to and from the platforms, the station has to be closed throughout the work.

For travel to Royal Oak:

- Change at Ladbrooke Grove for bus 7 or 23

- Change at Edgware Road for bus 18
- Change at Paddington for bus 36 or a short walk via Bishop's Bridge Road and Porchester Road

For travel from Royal Oak:

- Take bus 7 or 23 to Ladbrooke Grove station
- Take bus 18 to Edgware Road
- Take bus 36 to Paddington
- Walk to Warwick Avenue (for the Bakerloo line) or to Paddington

Escalator update for King's Cross St. Pancras

WORK to replace three escalators at King's Cross St. Pancras between the Northern line and eastbound Piccadilly line platforms is continuing.

As the station remains busy while the work carries on, particularly around the Northern line platforms, customers are advised to use alternative routes, such as interchanging between the Northern and

Victoria lines at Euston, or at Moorgate station between the Northern and Circle, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan lines.

By replacing all three escalators at the same time, the disruption to customers at the station will be reduced from 60 weeks to 36 weeks. Work started at the end of October last year and is scheduled to finish in early July.
