PLANNING AHEAD

Accessibility for all



BOARDING ramps used to bridge the gap between platforms and trains are to be introduced at 19 more Tube stations.

The move is one of a raft of measures to improve accessibility on the Underground outlined in the Mayor and Transport for London's (TfL's) 'Your Accessible Transport Network' document published last December. Progress is also being made on a number of other areas, including:

- The appointment of disability organisations to improve training for Tube staff in how they assist older and disabled passengers
- Establishing accessibility centres of excellence, to show how TfL can best assist disabled customers, at Stratford, King's Cross St. Pancras,

London Bridge, Green Park and Westminster stations

- Improving signage for step-free routes at 11 stations, with four more to be completed this summer. Positioned at locations and heights that are easily visible from wheelchairs, the signs provide better information on how best to navigate stations
- A passenger information system on the Victoria line which gives real-time travel information to help hearing impaired people who may miss driver announcements

There are no planned works this weekend on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Jubilee, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway or London Tramlink. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement work.

Central line

Station closure

Mile End: Closed Saturday to Monday owing to track replacement on the District and Hammersmith & City lines. See the District line entry for replacement buses.

District line

Part closure

Saturday – Monday: No service between Tower Hill and West Ham owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel and track replacement in the Aldgate East and Mile End areas. Replacement buses will run:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line)

District line

Service B: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for the Central and Jubilee lines, and Docklands Light Railway)

Hammersmith & City line

Part closure

Saturday – Monday: No service between Moorgate and Barking owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel and track replacement in the Aldgate East and Mile End areas. See the District line entry for replacement bus services.

Metropolitan line

Part closure

Saturday – Monday: No service between Wembley Park and Northwood/Uxbridge owing to track replacement work between Preston Road and Harrow-on-the-Hill. Use the Piccadilly line between Rayners Lane and Uxbridge. Replacement buses will run:

Service A: Wembley Park – Preston Road – Northwick Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Rayners Lane

Service B: Wembley Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Pinner – Northwood Hills – Northwood

Northern line

Part closure

Saturday – Monday: No service between Hampstead and Edgware owing to new signalling being installed. Replacement buses will run:

Service D: Chalk Farm – Belsize Park – Hampstead – Golders Green – Hendon Central – Colindale – Burnt Oak – Edgware – Canons Park (for the Jubilee line)

Service E: Chalk Farm – Belsize Park – Hampstead – Golders Green – Brent Cross – Hendon Central

London Overground

Part closure

Saturday and Sunday: No service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel. Replacement buses will call at all stations between Dalston Kingsland and Shadwell. Tickets will also be accepted on local bus and Tube services via all reasonable routes – these tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations.

Saturday and Sunday: No service between Surrey Quays and New Cross owing to Crossrail work at Whitechapel. Tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Saturday (after 7.15am) – Monday: No service between Highbury & Islington and Stratford owing to Network Rail bridge work. Replacement buses will run:

Service S: Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford

Service Q: Highbury & Islington – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Stratford

Tickets will also be accepted on Tube services via all reasonable routes – these tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Stratford and Canada Water stations.

Saturday (after 7.15am) – Monday: Platform 3 will be closed at Caledonian Road & Barnsbury owing to National Rail bridge work. All eastbound services will be diverted to platform 2. There will be no westbound services to/from this station. For westbound travel, take an eastbound service to Highbury & Islington and remain on the train, it will then depart Highbury & Islington and call at Camden Road and all stations to Richmond or Clapham Junction. Passengers boarding at Highbury & Islington for Caledonian Road & Barnsbury should take a westbound train to Camden Road and change there for an eastbound train to Caledonian Road & Barnsbury.
