

Will your journey be affected this weekend?

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, District, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee, Metropolitan, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, Docklands Light Railway, London Trams or TfL Rail. However, the following lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Changes to the Northern line

NORTHERN line services will operate differently next week while work takes place on the track.

Between Monday and Friday, northbound Bank branch services will only go towards Edgware and northbound Charing Cross branch services will only go towards High Barnet/Mill Hill East.

Camden Town station will be exit only between

4pm and 7pm and some trains may not stop at the station to prevent overcrowding. Southbound services will run as normal.

Customers are advised to plan ahead and start their journey on the correct branch.

Northern line

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Charing Cross/Moorgate and Hampstead/High Barnet/Mill Hill East owing to track replacement work at Camden Town. Replacement buses will operate, although routes may be affected by the Prudential RideLondon road closures:

Service A: Arnos Grove (for Piccadilly line) – North Finchley (Tally Ho Corner) – Woodside Park – Totteridge & Whetstone – High Barnet

Service B: King's Cross St. Pancras – Camden Town – Kentish Town – Tufnell Park – Archway – Highgate – East Finchley – Finchley Central

Service C: Mill Hill East – Finchley Central

Service D: Warren Street (for Victoria line and Euston Square station a three-minute walk away) – Mornington Crescent – Camden Town – Chalk Farm – Belsize Park – Hampstead – Golders Green – Finchley Road (for Jubilee and Metropolitan lines)

Service E: Arnos Grove (for Piccadilly line) – North Finchley (Tally Ho Corner) – West Finchley – Finchley Central

Camden Town station will be closed all weekend. Tufnell Park station will be closed on Saturday.

Finchley Central car park will be closed from 10pm this evening until 5am on Monday, August 1.

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: no service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell owing to Crossrail construction work. Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland or local buses between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Junction via all reasonable routes.

Rail replacement buses will run between Dalston Kingsland and Shadwell. Alternatively use London Underground services via all reasonable routes (entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only).

All weekend: no service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction owing to Crossrail construction work. Rail replacement buses will run between Canada Water and Clapham Junction.

All weekend: no service between Gospel Oak and Barking owing to Network Rail preparing the track for new, longer trains. Replacement buses will run between Gospel Oak and Seven Sisters (for South Tottenham), and Walthamstow Central to Barking. At East Ham, eastbound buses will set down only and westbound buses will pick up only.

Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road. Use Underground services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central and also between East Ham and Barking.

Three weeks to go until the launch of the Night Tube

THE first services on the Victoria and Central lines will begin on August 19, with services on the Jubilee, Northern and Piccadilly lines following in the autumn. The Night Tube will offer a 24-hour service on Fridays and Saturdays.



Plan for London cycling events

ROADS will close across the capital this weekend as thousands of riders and spectators arrive in the city for the Prudential RideLondon cycling festival.

There will be extensive closures along the routes from early morning, many buses will be on diversion and a number of bridges will be closed at times, too. Roads will reopen when it is safe to do so.

Drivers are advised that Birdcage Walk, Horse Guards Road, Spur Road, and The Mall will be closed from 7am today (Friday) until 6am on Monday.

People not attending the events are urged to check their routes before they travel and expect Tube stations to be busier than usual.

Reduced escalator service at Moorgate

PASSENGERS using the Northern line at Moorgate station, having entered the station or changed from other Tube lines, will need to use a spiral staircase from Monday when maintenance work starts on the escalators.

The maintenance repairs are expected to continue on the first escalator until mid-September. Work on the second escalator will be carried out between November and mid-December.

While the work takes place, the remaining operating escalator will run in the upwards direction only.
