



Posters pop up in London

STRIKING posters featuring some of London's iconic landmarks with the New Routemaster bus are being displayed at bus stops, Tube stations and advertising sites across the capital. The new poster collection, with designs from artist Paul Catherall, is London Transport Museum's first exhibition in its Transport Poster Art project, which is supported by advertising company Clear Channel.

A London-based artist, Paul is renowned for his clean, sharp linocuts of architectural landmarks and this series features the New Routemaster against some of the city's more famous backdrops, St Paul's, King's Cross station and Parliament.

HEAD to the MCN Motorcycle Show at the ExCeL Exhibition centre this weekend to see the BikeSafe London team.

Jointly run and funded by TfL and the Metropolitan Police Service, BikeSafe-London has been helping motorcyclists improve their knowledge, skills and experience to make them better and safer riders for more than a decade.

Since the scheme began, 27,000 riders have benefited from attending a Rider Skills Day run by qualified traffic police officers. The sessions combine observed rides with interactive presentations, discussions and advice on bike safety and improving riders' skills.

LINES were renewed and improvements made to track and drainage between Euston Square and Barbican to increase reliability on the Circle, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan lines. Station improvement works were also carried out

at Farringdon, Moorgate and Liverpool Street, ready for Crossrail.

Work to strengthen the tunnel lining between Bond Street and Baker Street also continued on the Jubilee line on Sunday morning.
