

Plan ahead for the festive season



The festive season is almost here. Use this handy guide to plan ahead with MetroTravel.

Christmas Eve

Buses: A Saturday service will run, with some exceptions. No night bus services. Twenty-four-hour routes will run until just after 12am.

Tube: Reduced weekday service with no evening peak boost. Reduced service after 8pm. Last trains will run at Sunday times with the exception of the Waterloo & City line, where the last services will be at 11.20pm from Waterloo, 11.26pm from Bank.

DLR: A weekday service will run until 2pm, followed by a reduced timetable will operate until 11pm.

Overground: A weekday service will run on all routes until around 9.30pm apart from between Highbury & Islington and New Cross/West Croydon/Clapham Junction, where there will be no services.

Trams: A Saturday service will run, with a reduced timetable after 8pm.

Christmas Day

No TfL services.

Boxing Day

Buses: A Sunday service will run. All 24-hour buses will start operating by 6am. Night buses will operate a Thursday service.

Tube: Trains start running from 8.30am, with last trains at Sunday times. Some engineering works will be taking place which means some stations or short sections of lines will be closed.

District line: No service throughout the day between Edgware Road, Earl's Court, Richmond, Ealing Broadway and Kensington (Olympia). After 6.30pm the South Kensington to

Wimbledon branch will be closed. Replacement buses will run.

Piccadilly line: Trains will call at District line stations between Hammersmith and Acton Town. Trains will also run to/from Ealing Broadway. North Ealing closed.

Jubilee line: No service between Waterloo and Finchley Road until December 31.

Waterloo & City line: No service.

Overground: No service.

DLR: Open between 8.30am and 11.30pm.

Trams: A Sunday service on most routes.

December 27

Buses: A Saturday service will run, with some exceptions.

Tube: Saturday services will run with some exceptions.

District line: No service until December 31. Replacement buses will run.

Piccadilly line: Until December 30, trains will call additionally at all District line stations between Hammersmith and Acton Town, and to/from Ealing Broadway.

Central line: Chancery Lane will be closed until December 31.

Overground: A Saturday service will run, except:

- No service between South Tottenham and Barking
- No service between Highbury & Islington and New Cross/Clapham Junction/Crystal Palace/West Croydon

Trams and DLR: Saturday service with some exceptions.

December 28

Buses: A Saturday service will run on all services.

Tube: A Saturday service will run some exceptions.

Northern line: Closed between Camden Town and Edgware.

Overground: Closed between South Tottenham and Barking.

December 29-30

Buses: Normal services will run on all routes.

Tube: Normal Sunday service.

Overground: Closed between South Tottenham and Barking.

New Year's Eve

Buses: A Saturday night service will run on night and twenty-four-hour routes, subject to road closures in central London. However, there will be some exceptions.

Tube, DLR and trams: Services will run all night on New Year's Eve. Some Tube stations will be closed completely or for periods at a time.

River: The London Eye pier will not be served until around 3pm. Some routes will run on New Year's Day, but a normal service will not resume until January 2.

New Year's Day

Buses: A Sunday service will run throughout the day, and a Wednesday night service will run on all twenty-four-hour routes and night bus routes.

Tube: Services will operate on all lines every 10-15 minutes in central London and every 20-30 minutes in outer areas until 10.30am. For the rest of the day, a reduced Sunday service will run.

DLR: A normal Saturday service will run.

Overground: A Saturday service will run but trains will start later.

Trams: A Sunday service will run.
