People leaving the venue may be diverted away from Hyde Park Corner station in the afternoons or early evenings, and a one-way system will be in operation at times at Marble Arch station.

Alternative stations, including Green Park, Knightsbridge and Victoria, can also be used.

### 1. SPECIAL EDITION JOHNSTON SCRABBLE £30 (WAS £40)

To mark the 100th anniversary of Tfl's Johnston font in 2016, the museum produced a special edition of the world-famous family game, with Johnston letters on the tiles and an engraved box.

The box is made from hemlock, mirroring the wooden finishes on buses, trains and stations that were in use between the 1930s and 1970s.

### 2. LONDON UNDERGROUND LIGHTBOX £30 (WAS £40)

Light up your life with one of London's most iconic designs. The lightbox features ten interchangeable station signs, including the classic 'Mind The Gap' slogan.

The freestanding or wall-mountable lamp is timeless, making it an ideal addition to the lounge, bedroom, office or hallway.

### 3. MOQUETTE HEART DECORATION £5.99 (WAS £9.99)

This charming heart-shaped Christmas decoration, made from vintage style B-Type bus moquette, is sure to add a unique touch to the tree this festive season.

### 4. RIDE ON BUS £56 (WAS £69.99)

This beautiful wooden bespoke ride on bus doubles up as a walker for little cruisers. It is based on the original London red bus, bringing a touch of retro design to your toy collection.

Bright and enticing, it's perfect for keeping toddlers entertained while helping to develop motor skills and balance. It also features built-in storage so children can take their favourite toys along for the ride.

### 5. HIDDEN LONDON TORCH £3.20 (WAS £7.99)

Inspired by London Transport Museum's Hidden London tours, this torch will come in handy to look for hidden things in and around your home. It is also a great gift for adventurous children.
