Weekend closures on the Central line

CLOSURES on the Central line this weekend and next will enable more improvement work to be carried out.

Together with enhancements in the Leytonstone area, a platform at Buckhurst Hill station will be rebuilt at the same time, removing the need for separate closures.

For the fastest journeys to central London during this time, replacement bus services will connect with National Rail services at Chingford, Ilford, Stratford and Walthamstow Central for onward journeys to Liverpool Street. Replacement and local buses will also connect with the District, Hammersmith

& City, Jubilee and Victoria lines.

Valid Tube tickets and Oyster cards will also be accepted on National Rail services and local bus routes in the affected areas.

For detailed travel advice, including a map of alternative services, pick up a 'Central line closures' leaflet from Tube stations east of Liverpool Street.

Central and Waterloo & City lines general manager, Tricia Ashton, said 'The package of work we are carrying out as part of the Tube improvement plan will result in improved service reliability and provide passengers with a more comfortable ride.'

There are no planned track works on the Bakerloo, Circle, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee, Metropolitan, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or London Tramlank. However, the following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

Bakerloo line

Station closure

Edgware Road: Closed until late December owing to lift replacement work. Edgware Road (Circle and Hammersmith & City lines) is the nearest alternative station. Trains from here connect with Bakerloo line services at Baker Street and Paddington.

Central line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Bethnal Green and Loughton via Hainault/Woodford. On Sunday the closure will extend to Liverpool Street until 8am. This is while track and points are replaced in the Leytonstone area, and station improvement work is carried out at Buckhurst Hill. Replacement bus services will run:

Service A: Woodford – Roding Valley – Chigwell – Grange Hill – Hainault – Fairlop – Fullwell Cross – Barkingside – Newbury Park – Ilford (for Greater Anglia services)

Service B: Newbury Park – Gants Hill – Redbridge – Wanstead – Snaresbrook – Walthamstow Central (for the Victoria line and Greater Anglia services)

Service C: Loughton – Buckhurst Hill – Roding Valley – Woodford – South Woodford – Snaresbrook – Leytonstone – Leyton – Stratford (for the Jubilee line, Docklands Light Railway and Greater Anglia services)

At busy times, bus journeys between Leyton and Leytonstone may be delayed owing to heavy traffic. For journeys to/from central London, you may find it faster to travel via Chingford, Ilford or Walthamstow Central for the Victoria line or National Rail services.

Service D: Leytonstone – Stratford (for the Jubilee line, Docklands Light Railway and Greater Anglia services)

Service E: Woodford – South Woodford – Snaresbrook – Walthamstow Central (for the Victoria line and Greater Anglia services)

Service F: Loughton – Chingford (for Greater Anglia services)

District line

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Dagenham East and Upminster owing to line improvement work at Upminster and drainage replacement work at Elm Park. Replacement buses will call at: Dagenham East – Elm Park – Hornchurch – Upminster Bridge – Upminster.

Docklands Light Railway

Part closure

All weekend: No service between Canning Town and Beckton owing to Crossrail work at Custom House. Replacement bus services will run:

- Canning Town to Beckton (not serving Royal Victoria station)
- Canning Town to ExCeL via Emirates Royal Docks (shuttle service)

London Overground

Part closure

All weekend: Platform 3 at Caledonian Road & Barnsbury will be closed owing to Network Rail track work. All eastbound services arriving and departing from this station will be diverted to platform 2. There will be no westbound services to/from this station.

To travel westbound at Caledonian Road & Barnsbury, take an eastbound service to Highbury & Islington and remain on the train. It will then depart Highbury & Islington and call at Camden Road, then all stations to Richmond/Clapham Junction. Customers boarding at Highbury & Islington and wishing to travel to Caledonian Road & Barnsbury, should take a westbound train directly to Camden Road and change there for an eastbound train to Caledonian Road & Barnsbury.

All weekend: No service between Highbury & Islington and Stratford owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement bus services will run:

Route S: Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford

Route Q: Highbury & Islington – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Stratford

Sunday: No service between New Cross Gate and West Croydon until 10am owing to Network Rail track work. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: No service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace until 9.30am owing to Network Rail track work. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Sunday: No service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will call at: Canada Water – Surrey Quays – Queens Road Peckham – Peckham Rye – Denmark Hill – Clapham High Street – Wandsworth.
