

Plan your weekend travel

Find out about line closures and alternative travel options at tfl.gov.uk

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Circle, Hammersmith & City, Jubilee, Northern, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines this weekend. There are also no planned works on the DLR or London Trams. However, engineering and improvement work will affect the following services:

District line Part closure

Saturday and Sunday: No service between Turnham Green and Richmond for Network Rail signalling repairs and track work. Replacement buses will operate:

- Willesden Junction – Acton Central – South Acton – Turnham Green – Chiswick Park – Gunnersbury – Kew Gardens – Richmond

Metropolitan line Part closure

Sunday: No service between Wembley Park and Aldgate until 9.30am and after 8.30pm each day. This is owing to track replacement work. Use Jubilee line services between Wembley Park and Baker Street, or Chiltern Railways between Marylebone and Harrow-on-the-Hill.

London Overground Part closure

Richmond/Clapham Junction to Stratford route

Saturday and Sunday: No service between Willesden Junction and Richmond. This is owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will operate:

- Willesden Junction – Acton Central – South Acton – Turnham Green (for District line) – Chiswick Park (for District line) – Gunnersbury – Kew Gardens – Richmond

Sunday: No service between Willesden Junction and Clapham Junction. This is owing to Network Rail infrastructure work and Earls Court development work. Use local buses.

Sunday: No service between Willesden Junction and Camden Road until 11.30am, owing to Network Rail track and infrastructure work. Replacement buses will operate:

- Willesden Junction – Kensal Rise – Queen’s Park (for local buses to Brondesbury Park) – Brondesbury – West Hampstead – Finchley Road (for Jubilee and Metropolitan lines, and Finchley Road & Frognal) – Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (Agincourt Road/Southampton Road) – Kentish Town West – Camden Road

Highbury & Islington to New Cross/Clapham Junction/ Crystal Palace/West Croydon route

Sunday: No service between Sydenham and Crystal Palace from 8.45pm until 11.15pm. This is owing to Crossrail construction work. Use local buses instead.

Sunday: No service between Surrey Quays and New Cross from 8.45pm, owing to Crossrail construction work. Use bus route 225 or services from New Cross Gate station instead.

Sunday: No service between Highbury & Islington and Shadwell from 9.15pm, owing to Crossrail construction work. Rail replacement buses will operate:

- Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell

Romford to Upminster route

Sunday: No service between Romford and Upminster for Crossrail construction work and Network Rail track work. Use local bus route 370 instead.

TfL Rail Part closure

Sunday: No service between Chadwell Heath and Shenfield until 8.05am, while Network Rail replace overhead lines. Replacement buses will operate:

- Chadwell Heath (Wangey Road) – Romford – Gidea Park – Harold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield

What’s on and how to get there

If you’re planning to go to any of these big events this weekend, see below for your nearest stations.

Television Centre food festival

Head down to the BBC’s former home in White City for a three-day food extravaganza. Free to attend, the festival features interactive workshops, pop-up food stalls and a live performance by the BBC Concert Orchestra.

Nearest stations: White City (Central line) or Wood Lane (Circle and Hammersmith & City lines).

Games Character Parade

Watch hundreds of gaming icons come to life as this colourful parade takes to the streets of London on Saturday. The familiar characters will set off from Guildhall Yard at 12.30pm,

before making their way to Paternoster Square. There will also be a family activity zone in Guildhall Yard.

Nearest stations: Guildhall Yard is about four minutes from Bank (Central, Northern and Waterloo & City lines), five minutes from Moorgate (Northern line), and six minutes from St Paul’s (Central line) and Mansion House (Circle and District lines).

The National Wedding Show

The UK’s biggest wedding show is once again at ExCel Arena, with hundreds of industry experts offering advice to brides and grooms-to-be.

Nearest station: Exit at Prince Regent station (DLR) for the ExCel Arena east entrance. You can also travel to the ExCel on the Emirates Air Line from North Greenwich Tube or Pier.

Advice for passengers using the District line

THERE is a reduced service on the District line today owing to a strike by ASLEF trade union members.

There will be delays on the District line throughout the day, so customers should allow more time to complete journeys or change to a different line if possible. All other Tube lines are running as normal. District line services are expected to return to normal tomorrow morning.

There are no services to Kensington (Olympia), however London Overground and Southern services are calling at the station as usual. Travel Ambassadors will be at key locations to provide information and advice.
